## **Board deliberates**

— Board considers the written and oral presentations received and determines the weight it gives to the evidence it hears





# Appeals can be filed

— To appeal, you must file a Notice of Appeal with the Clerk of the SDAB





Prepare information and evidence — Gather relevant materials or documents to support the appeal



## **Board makes decision**

— Written decision is issued within 15 days following the hearing and is posted online and mailed to those who appeared before the Board.

A decision may be appealed to the Alberta Court of Appeal within 30 days after the decision is issued





Hearing is scheduled within 30 days — after receipt of appeal





**Submit evidence** — Provide evidence to the Clerk of SDAB by deadlines on the notice of hearing
