Rural Water and Sewer Servicing (RWSS) Draper Update

NEXT STEPS: LOT BY LOT ASSESSMENT

Thank you to all residents who participated in the lot by lot assessment. The information gathered will be compiled and presented to Council in the fall. The lot by lot assessment process will help support the proposed on-site service connection plan that was presented on November 27, 2018. This plan includes how and when residents will be able to pay their service connection fee.

The on-site service connection plan is being drafted into a by-law for Council's approval. This means that the by-law must be read three times in a public meeting for Council's consideration. The aim of the proposed on-site service connection plan is to finalize service connection fees and all other aspects of the program. For more information please visit www.rmwb.ca/rwss

The paving of 4 km of Draper Road is still scheduled for this construction season, with the first lift of asphalt now anticipated to be completed by October 2019, depending on weather conditions. The second lift of asphalt will be completed in the summer of 2020. During construction, community access will be maintained at all times. We request that drivers adhere the posted speed limit and follow all temporary traffic accommodation signs.

The Municipality is in the design stage of upgrading the road structure and roadside drainage of Garden Lane Road in Draper. The project team have completed a topographical ground survey of the area and will be reaching out to residents to share their findings and discuss next steps in the project.

This year, all construction notices are being delivered to your front door. Please check periodically for correspondence if you see construction crews nearing your home.
