

BIN PLACEMENT GUIDELINES

We've added automated collection trucks to our curbside collection fleet and to help them collect your garbage and recycling efficiently there are some new guidelines for placing your bins.

- In winter months, place bins in front of windrows and snow banks and clear ice and snow from the collection area
- Do not cover bins with sheets or blankets
- Ensure bin lids are completely closed
- Bins must be at least 30 cm (one foot) from other bins and at least one metre (three feet) from surrounding vehicles
- On streets with parking congestion, your curbside bins can be pulled away from the curb and towards the roadway (but not past the side view mirrors on the vehicles). Bins cannot block traffic flow
