



Rural Water & Sewer Servicing (RWSS) – January Update

We're busy planning open houses for 2017. Please stay tuned to your regular channels for updates on times and venues.

Anzac & Gregoire Lake Estates (GLE)

We're doing tree removal on Crown land in Gregoire Lake Estates to make way for construction. The removal areas are adjacent to Poplar Crescent and Highway 881 (see inset map). The trees will tentatively be removed by February 15 and every effort will be made to reduce noise and disruption to residents.

Designs for the new reservoir, pumphouse and sanitary lift station are finished. The construction work will be tendered in February.

Conklin and Janvier

Work on the lift stations and water treatment plant in Conklin will start this spring with the aim of bringing potable water to the Northland School Division. Construction is expected to finish by the fall of 2018.

Design of the water distribution system and sanitary sewer for Pine Lane, Poplar Drive, Conklin Drive and Spruce Drive is done.

The municipality is tendering the construction to start this spring with work tentatively finishing in late 2018.

In Janvier, construction of water lines along roadways and road rehabilitation work will tentatively take place this spring.

Draper and Saprae Creek

Some design challenges are being addressed in Draper – more information will be provided in next month's update.
