NEXT STEPS: LOT BY LOT ASSESSMENT

Thank you to all residents who participated in the lot by lot assessment. The information gathered will be compiled and presented to Council in the fall. The lot by lot assessment process will help support the proposed on-site service connection plan that was presented on November 27, 2018. This plan includes how and when residents will be able to pay their service connection fee.

The on-site service connection plan is being drafted into a by-law for Council's approval. This means that the by-law must be read three times in a public meeting for Council's consideration. The aim of the proposed on-site service connection plan is to finalize service connection fees and all other aspects of the program. For more information please visit www.rmwb.ca/rwss

H.Wilson is continuing underground and road construction in Sapræ Creek Estates. Road work has begun on Weiss Drive with minimal disruptions to driveway access anticipated. Weiss Drive is now paved from Spruce Valley Drive to Spruce Valley Gate, and the next stage of paving is from Weiss Drive from Spruce Valley Gate to Janke Lane intersection. Community Lane ditch grading and landscaping is ongoing. Culvert drainage on Sommer Way will be restored by the end of the construction season.

Weaver Group Ltd. is completing the sanitary pipeline system along Sapræ Creek Trail, A Frame Road and the south area of Sol Park Drive. Chandos will be mobilizing in September to begin work on a new sewage lift station at the Sapræ Creek Estates Firehall property. Minimal disruption to residents is expected. Temporary traffic diversions and one-lane closures may occur to complete intermittent equipment and material deliveries.

During construction, we are working in close cooperation with emergency services to ensure your safety is cared for. We thank you for your patience and consideration while we continue to make improvements to the Sapræ Creek Estates community.
