

**Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo Combative Sports Commission
Policy #3 – Uniform Policy**

Effective Date: June 13, 2019

Review Date: June 13, 2020

STATEMENT:

The Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo Combative Sports Commission will ensure all Commission members and officials are dressed in a safe and professional uniform for Combative Sports Events within the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo.

PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVE:

The objective of this policy is to outline the official uniform requirements of Commission members and officials hired for approved Combative Sports Events in the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo.

PROCEDURES:

1. Definitions

- 1.1. Commission – means the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo Combative Sports Commission, established by Bylaw no.13/019
- 1.2. Combative Sports Event or Event – means an approved Combative Sports competition with one or more Contests
- 1.3. Official – means an individual who is authorized by the Commission to provide services to an Event, including, but not limited to judges, timekeepers, dressing-room supervisors, seconds, referees, medical advisers, ringside physicians, scorekeepers, knockdown judges, paymasters, ring generals, technical advisors, corner supervisors and inspectors

2. Responsibilities

- 2.1. Commission Chair:
 - Will ensure all Commission members and officials abide by this policy.

3. Scope

- 3.1. This policy only applies to Commission members and officials hired for an approved Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo Combative Sports Event by the Commission.

4. Non-Compliance

- 4.1. Failure to adhere to this policy may result in:

4.1.1. The official may not be considered for future events.

5. General Procedures

5.1. Referee Uniform

Referees shall wear:

- 5.1.1. A black shirt with the Commission logo displayed, provided by the Commission (Mixed Martial Event) or a black dress shirt (Boxing or Kickboxing Event), not provided by the Commission.
- 5.1.2. A lanyard, provided by the Commission, granting access to restricted Event areas.
- 5.1.3. Black pants, and are not provided by the Commission.
- 5.1.4. Clean, indoor shoes, and are not provided by the Commission.

5.2. Judge Uniform

Judges shall wear:

- 5.2.1. A black shirt with the Commission logo displayed, provided by the Commission.
- 5.2.2. A wristband, provided by the Commission, granting access to restricted Event areas.
- 5.2.3. Black pants, and are not provided by the Commission.
- 5.2.4. Clean, indoor shoes, and are not provided by the Commission.

5.3. Doctor Uniform

Doctors shall wear:

- 5.3.1. A wristband, provided by the Commission, granting access to restricted Event areas.
- 5.3.2. Clean, indoor shoes, and are not provided by the Commission.

5.4. Timekeeper Uniform

Timekeepers shall wear:

- 5.4.1. A red shirt with the Commission logo displayed, provided by the Commission.
- 5.4.2. A wristband, provided by the Commission, granting access to restricted Event areas.

5.5. Room Attendant/Supervisor Uniform

Room Attendants/Supervisors shall wear:

- 5.5.1. A red shirt with the Commission logo displayed, provided by the Commission.
- 5.5.2. Clean, indoor shoes, and are not provided by the Commission.
- 5.5.3. A wristband, provided by the Commission, granting access to restricted Event areas.
- 5.5.4. If this duty is being filled by a Commission member, the Commission Member Uniform will be utilized.

5.6. Commission Member Uniform

RMWB Combative Sports Commission members shall wear:

5.6.1. A black shirt with the Commission logo displayed, provided by the Commission.

5.6.2. Clean, indoor shoes, and are not provided by the Commission.

5.6.3. Event tag, listing all key Event contacts information.

5.6.4. Name tag, provided by the Commission.

5.7. Exceptions

5.7.1. All other uniform combinations must have prior approval from the Commission, before it can be worn at an Event.

Approval

This policy shall be reviewed in one (1) year from its effective date to determine its effectiveness and appropriateness. This policy may be assessed before that time as necessary to reflect best practices.
