



## FAQ

### **What is Shootout on the Snye?**

Shootout on the Snye is a 4 on 4 pond hockey tournament which takes place during the annual WinterPlay Festival. Hockey games take place on the Clearwater River, at Snye Park from February 24 to 26, 2022. Each team will consist of 4 – 6 players.

### **What is different this year?**

For age groups U7-U18, registration is completed as an individual player and teams will be created by the tournament organizers. The Adult Division will register as a team of 4-6 players with the option of a competitive or non-competitive division (dependent on numbers of registration).

### **Why was this change made?**

The results of a recent public engagement survey showed that participants would like tournament organizers to create the teams for the youth divisions. This will help to ensure an equal level of play for all teams.

### **How can I register?**

Registration for Shootout on the Snye can be completed at [www.rmwb.ca/winterPLAY](http://www.rmwb.ca/winterPLAY). Registration will be individual this year for age groups U7 – U 18. Please note: There are no goalies in this tournament.

### **What is the cost to register?**

The early bird pricing is \$30/player, until January 22, 2022. \$40/player starting January 23, 2022. The deadline to register a team for Shootout on the Snye is January 31, 2022.

### **What are the divisions?**

Players of all ages and skill levels can register for Shootout on the Snye. Age groups are U7-U18 and there is an Adult Division consisting of 18+.

**Please note the following:**

1. Teams will only consist of players within the same division unless otherwise specified
2. The Adult Division will have a competitive and non-competitive pool, depending on number of teams registered and can still register in teams of 4-6 players.

**How many games will I play?**

Each division will consist of one or two round robins, guaranteeing that all teams have a minimum of 3 games. Total number of games will vary depending on the number of teams registered.

**When will I receive the game schedule?**

Schedules, along with team jerseys and event information will be provided at the mandatory Shootout on the Snye orientation.

**When is the Shootout on the Snye orientation?**

A representative from each team must attend a Shootout on the Snye Orientation, taking place via Microsoft Teams on February 21 at 12pm **OR** 6pm. Attendees can drop-in at the South Operations Centre (140 Sapræe Creek Trails (aka Airport Road) between February 21-23 to pick up Team Packages.

**What are the rules for Shootout on the Snye?**

A detailed list of rules will be included with each registration package, emailed to all team coaches, and will be posted at the event site.

Each team will be required to referee 3 other team's games throughout the tournament.

**Why are referees not part of Shootout on the Snye?**

As the Shootout on the Snye is not an Alberta Hockey sanctioned event, the Referee Association is not able to provide officials to our tournament.

**Is there a Waiver and Photo Release Form for the tournament?**

All players over 18 must agree to the waiver and photo release policy when registering online. Players under 18 must have a guardian or parent sign the waiver and photo release form. Completed forms are due on February 15, 2022. Forms can also be found on the WinterPLAY website:
