[Order 54-2021](#) – Updates details and scope of Restrictions Exemption Program.

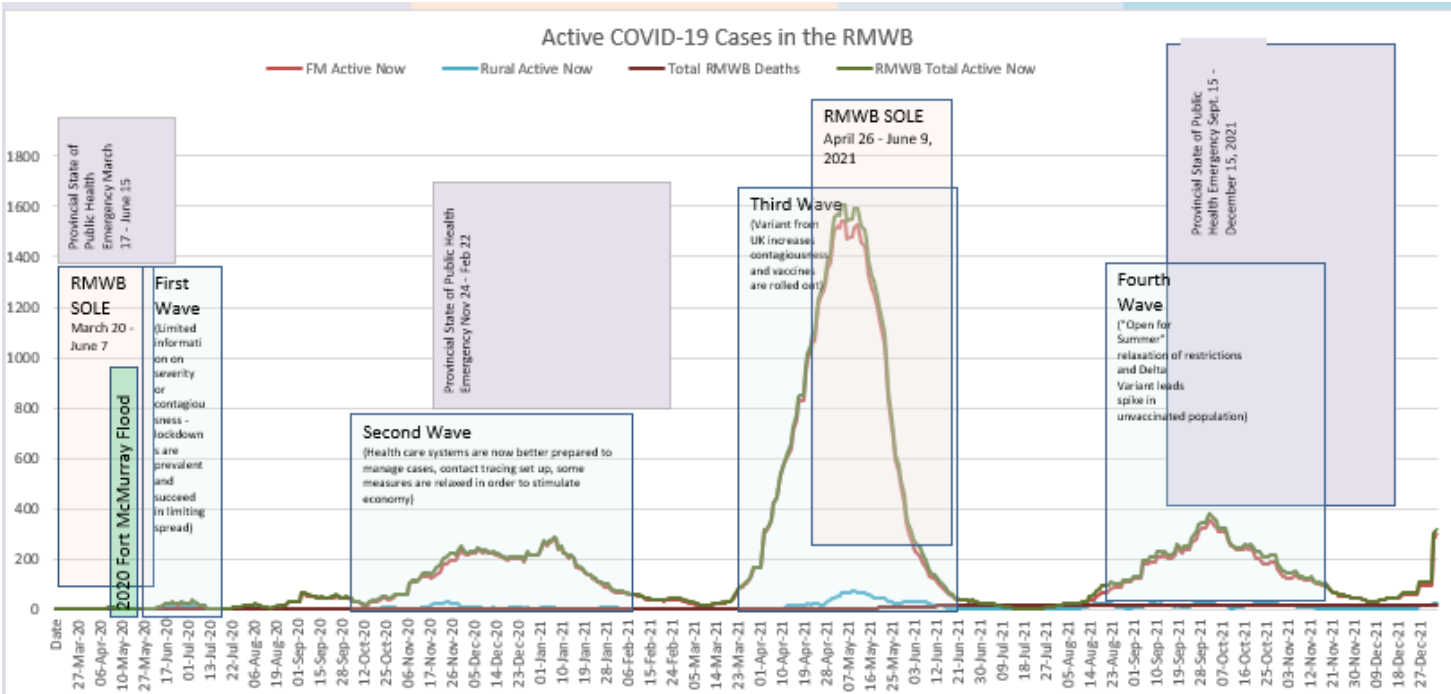

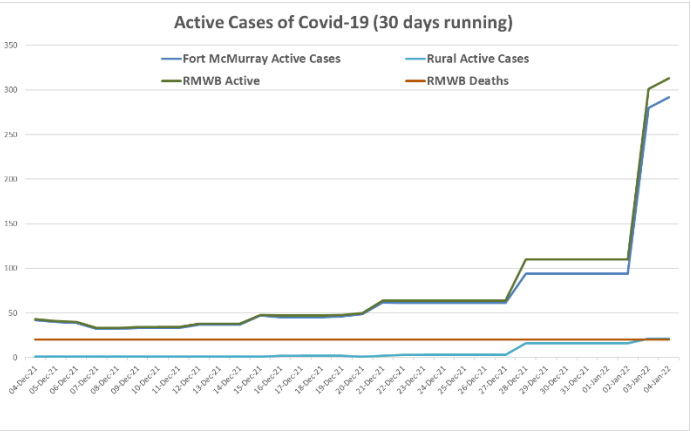
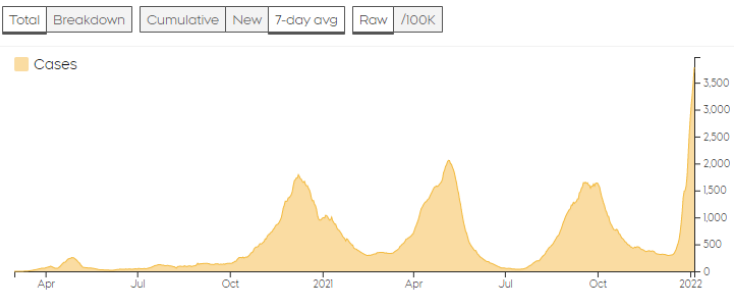
Canada (click map for provincial stats)
