Did you know? If you are asymptomatic and fully vaccinated, you may leave isolation after 5 days, however, you are required to adhere to continuous masking for another 5 days.

Unvaccinated people who are symptomatic or test positive are required to isolate for the full 10 days, or longer until symptoms resolve. If you have exited your isolation, you must wait for a negative rapid test before you may enter REP facilities. Household contacts of positive unvaccinated cases are requested to isolate for 14 days. 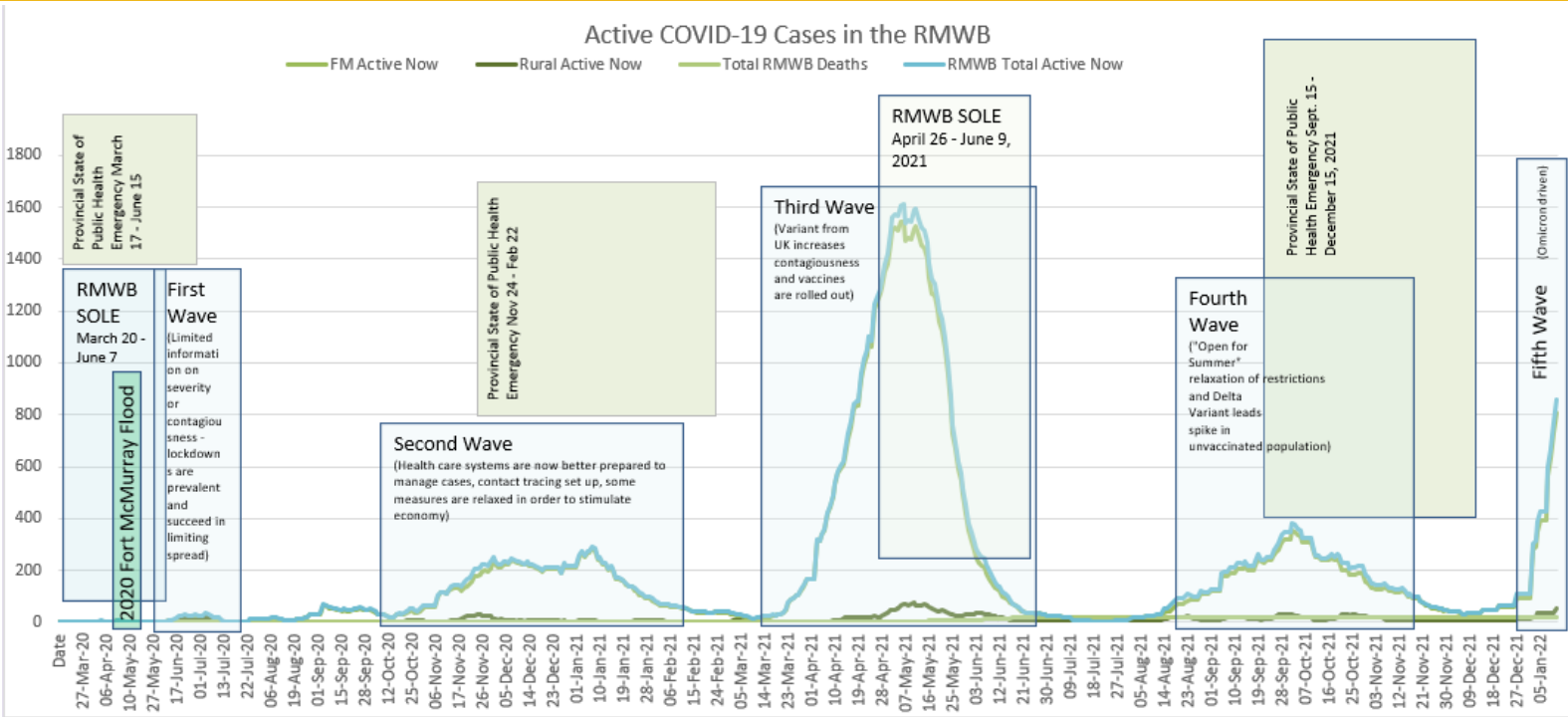
