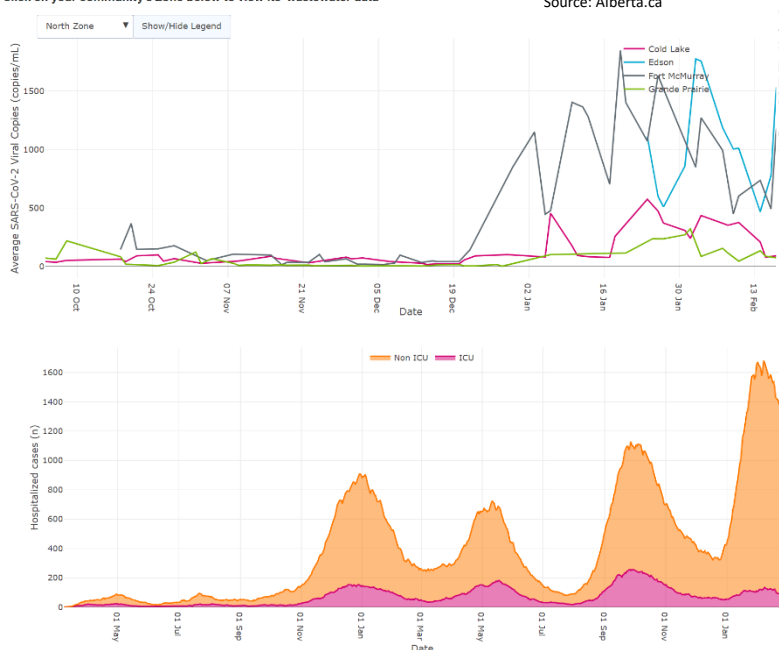

Premier Kenney spoke Saturday morning and confirmed that Alberta will move into Step 2 of the provincial re-opening plan.

- **STEP 2: March 1st at 12am**
 - Indoor masking no longer required, except on public transit (not Taxis or Uber) and high-risk settings including AHS facilities, and public care facilities.
 - Remaining school requirements removed
 - Work from home requirement removed
 - Gathering limits lifted (inside and outside)
 - Capacity limits in all venues lifted
 - Health screening for youth activities removed

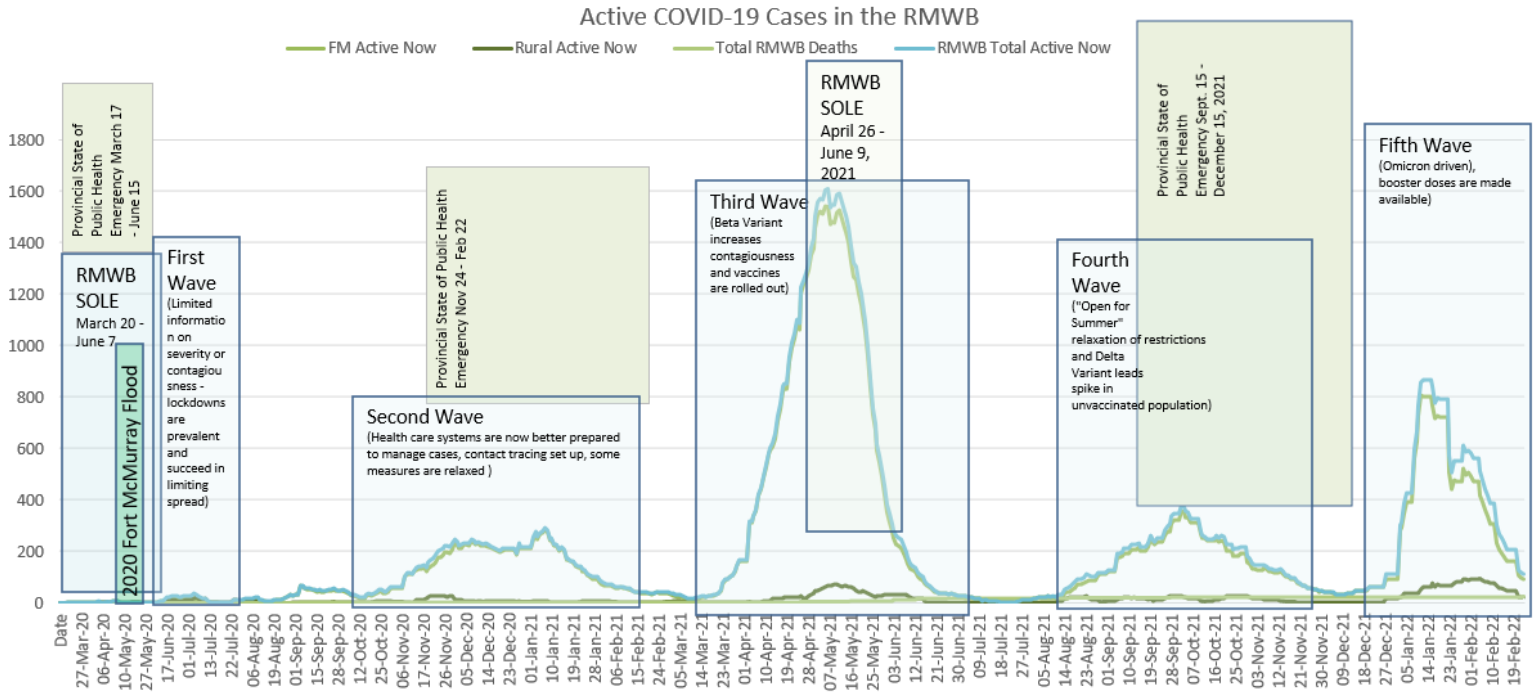

Note: Premier Kenney said about 40% of current hospitalizations included in these statistics are those hospitalized for other reasons that happen to also have a Covid-19 infection.



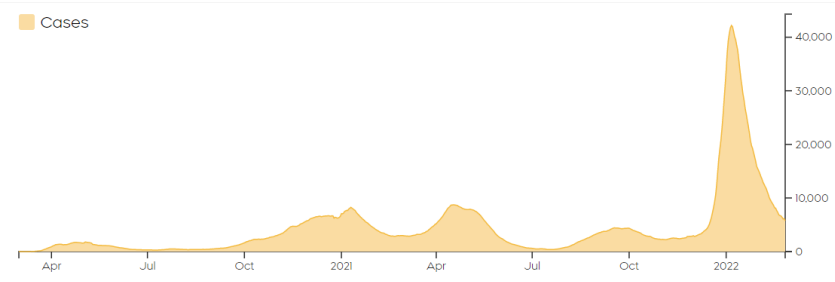

Total Breakdown Cumulative New 7-day avg Raw /100K

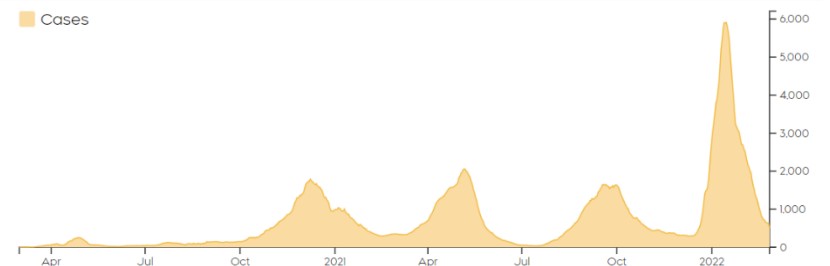


Canadian travel protocols are changing often:
