- Outdoor Social Gatherings up to 20 people.
- Indoor recreation and entertainment settings open at 1/3 fire code
- Gyms and fitness studio open with 3 metre distancing
- Funerals and Weddings up to 20 people
- Personal and wellness services resume walk-in service
- Post-secondary resume in-person learning
- Restaurants - 6 people per table max, indoors or outdoors
- Retail - 1/3 of fire code capacity
- Work from home order lifted but still recommended

- 3 prizes of \$1 Million in each of July, August, and September. Travel Prizes have been added.
- One entry per draw, per person for those who have received at least one dose of Covid-19 Vaccine.

Stage 3 will begin July 1st.

At this stage, all restrictions will be lifted, including ban on indoor social gatherings.

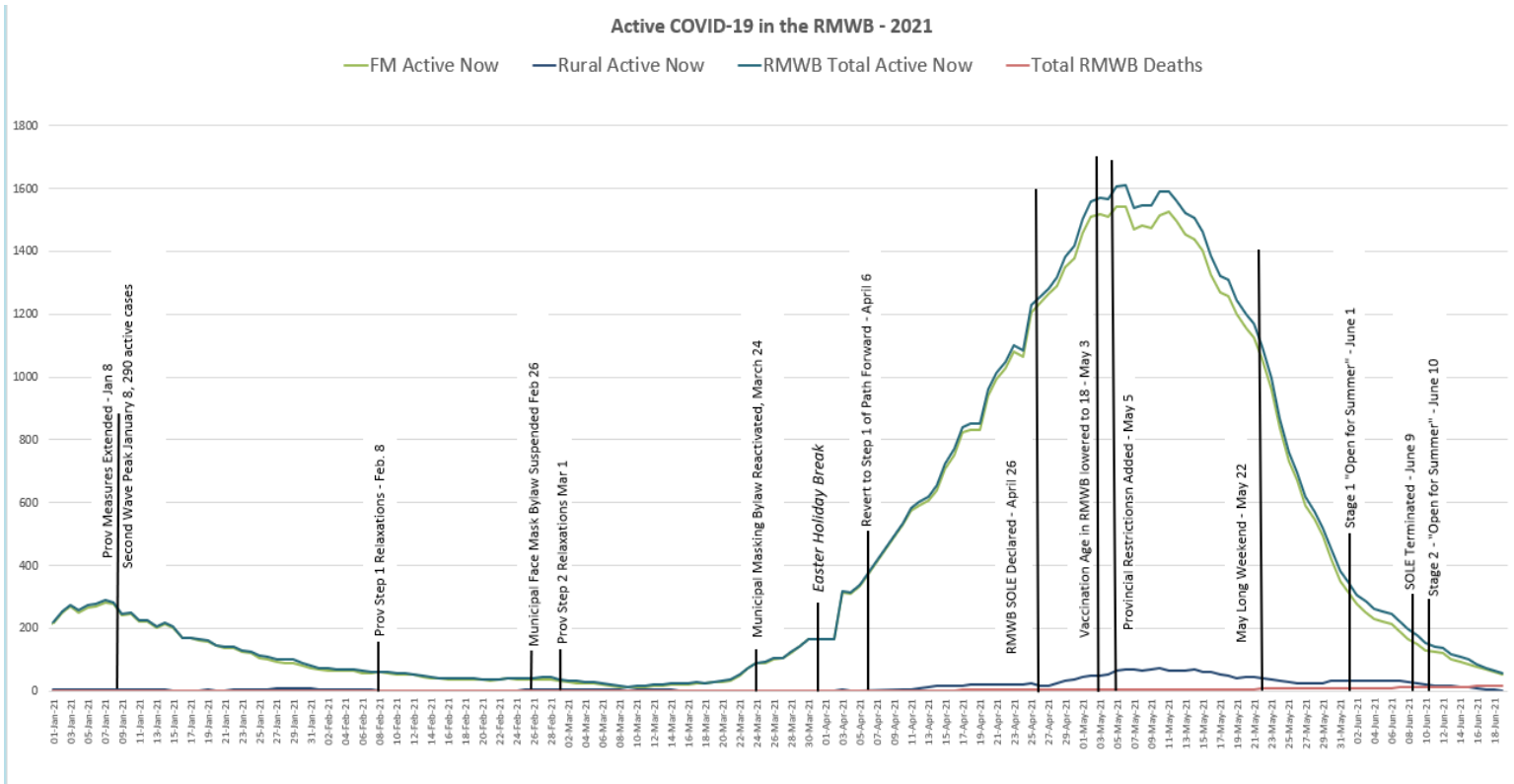
Isolation requirements for confirmed cases and some protective measures in continuing care situations remain.

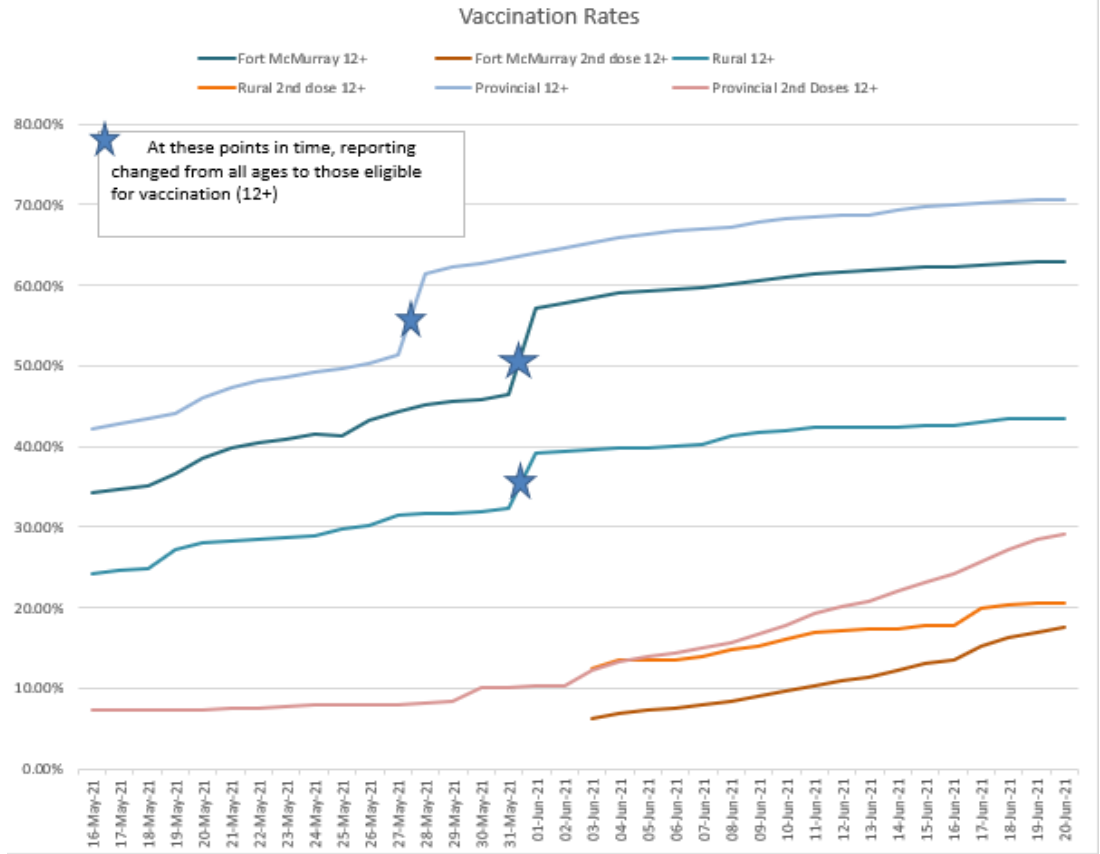

Where possible, AHS and participating pharmacies who administered your first dose will contact you when you are eligible for your second dose. You do not need to wait to be contacted to book an appointment once you are eligible and you can choose where to go to get your second dose.

Second Dose:

Every Albertan should get their second dose when they're eligible. A single dose of COVID-19 vaccine offers at least 73% protection against severe outcomes, including hospitalization and death. However, second doses are needed to get the best and most long-lasting protection.

The following information was presented regarding 2nd doses.

- Alberta will have sufficient supply of each vaccine to provide 2nd doses
- Anyone who received 1st dose of AstraZeneca in April or later can book second dose (either AstraZeneca or mRNA) at least 8 weeks after the 1st dose.

- Quarantine rules have changed for people who are fully immunized:
 - People with 2 doses no longer need to quarantine if they are exposed to someone with Covid-19 if they have no symptoms.
 - People with 1st dose have shorter quarantine requirements

P.1 Brazilian Variant	75%	89%
B.1.617.2 Delta Variant	33%	88%
