- Outdoor Social Gatherings up to 20 people.
- Indoor recreation and entertainment settings open at 1/3 fire code
- Gyms and fitness studio open with 3 metre distancing
- Funerals and Weddings up to 20 people
- Personal and wellness services resume walk-in service
- Post-secondary resume in-person learning
- Restaurants - 6 people per table max, indoors or outdoors
- Retail - 1/3 of fire code capacity
- Work from home order lifted but still recommended

Stage 3 will begin July 1st

At this stage, all restrictions will be lifted, including ban on indoor social gatherings.

Masking mandate will be lifted, but will still be required in limited and specific settings, including acute care settings, public transit, taxis, and ride-share services.

Vaccination Lottery

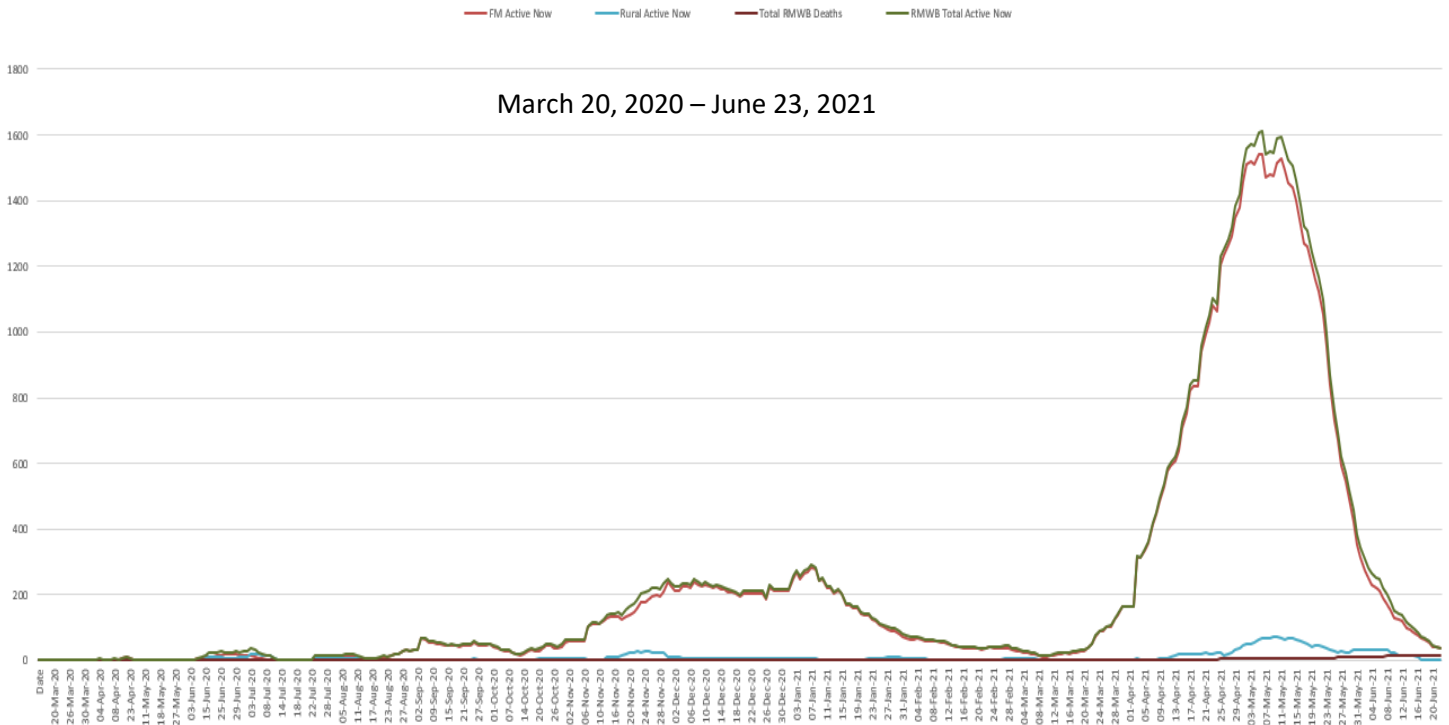
- 3 prizes of \$1 Million in each of July, August, and September. Travel Prizes and Calgary Stamped prizes have been added.

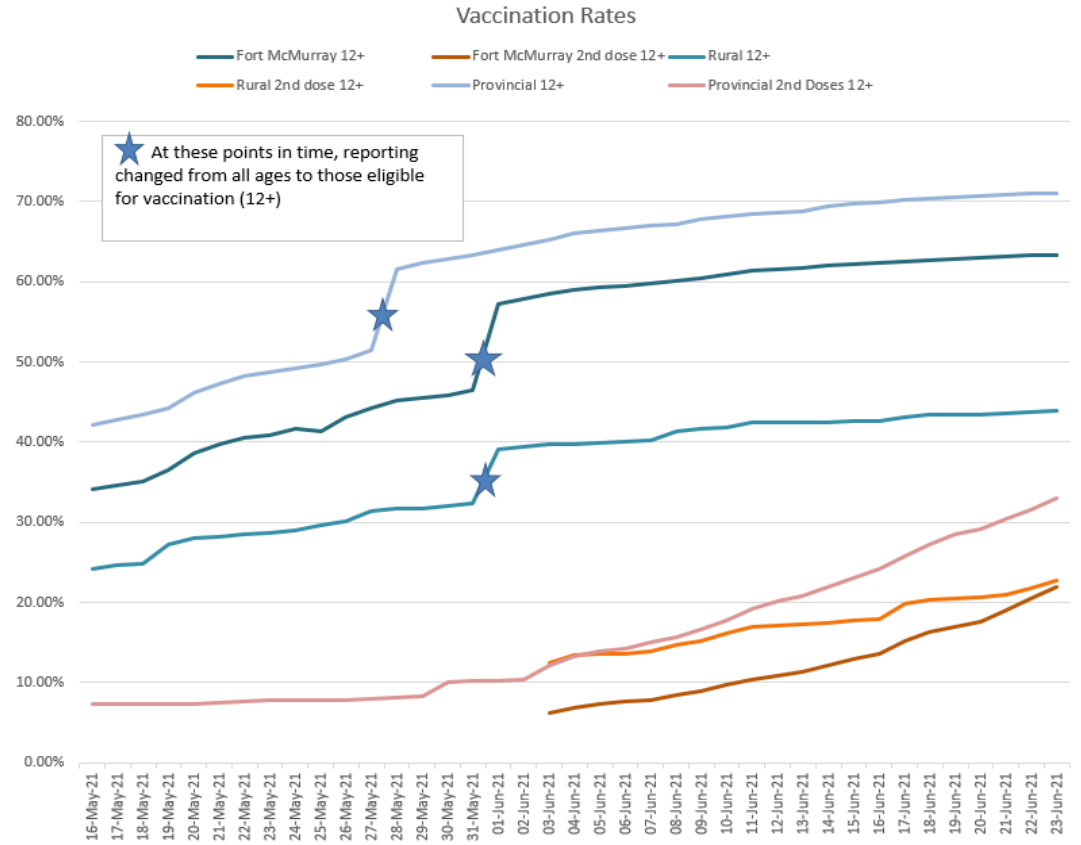

New vaccination information:

First Dose	Book

Where possible, AHS and participating pharmacies who administered your first dose will contact you when you are eligible for your second dose. You do not need to wait to be contacted to book an appointment once you are eligible and you can choose where to go to get your second dose.

Second Dose:

If you got an **mRNA vaccine (Pfizer or Moderna)** for your first dose, you should get an mRNA vaccine for your second dose to become fully vaccinated, but it doesn't need to be the same brand. Both Pfizer and Moderna are considered interchangeable so book the first appointment available.

Youth ages 12 to 17 must receive the Pfizer vaccine for both doses. Book your second dose 4 weeks after your first dose.

If you got **AstraZeneca** for your first dose, you can choose either the AstraZeneca vaccine or an mRNA vaccine (Pfizer/Moderna) for your second dose.

Both options will provide additional protection and count as completing your immunization in Canada. International jurisdictions may have different standards for a complete immunization series.

Book your second dose 8 weeks after your first dose of AstraZeneca
