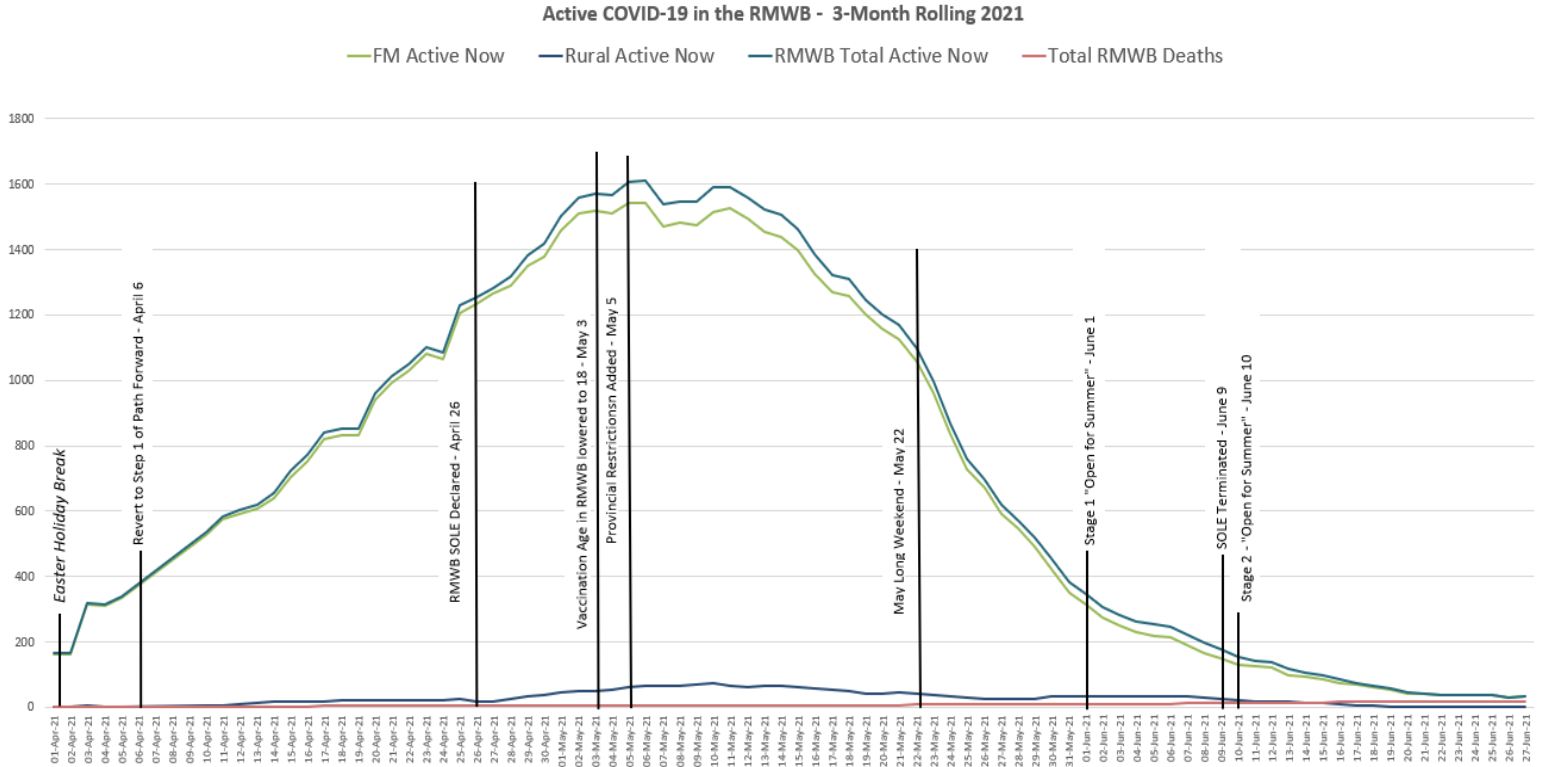
## Vaccination Lottery

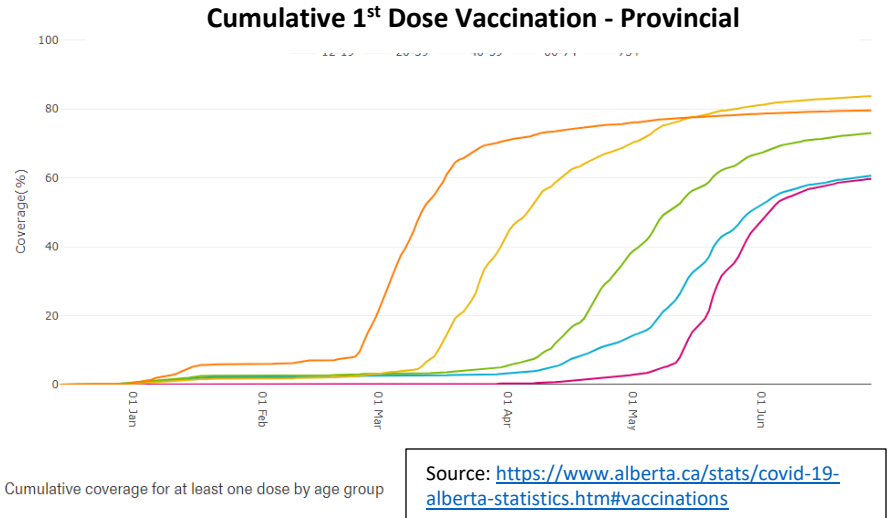
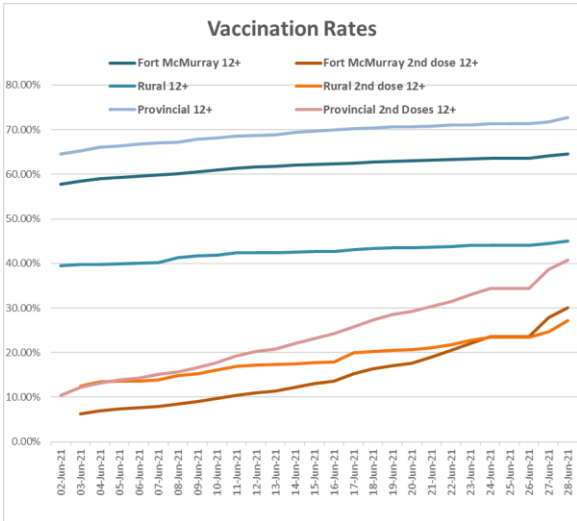

## Isolation and Quarantine Requirements for Vaccinated Albertans:

**Fully Vaccinated:** If you are fully-vaccinated\* and are exposed to a COVID-19 case:

- If you have no symptoms, you are not required to quarantine.
- If you do have symptoms, you must isolate for 10 days and should get tested – your isolation can end early if you test negative.

**If you are partially vaccinated\* and are exposed to a COVID-19 case:**

- Your quarantine can end early if you test negative on day 7 or later.
- If you test negative before day 7, you must remain in quarantine and need a second negative test on day 7 or later to end quarantine.

**If you do have symptoms, you must isolate and should get tested:**

- Your quarantine can end early if you test negative on day 7 or later.
- If you test negative before day 7, you must remain in quarantine and need a second negative test on day 7 or later to end quarantine.

\*You are considered fully vaccinated 14 days after receiving both doses in a 2-dose vaccine series, or 1 dose in a 1 dose vaccine series. You are considered partially vaccinated 14 days after receiving the first dose in a 2-dose vaccine series.

## Second Dose:

If you received an **mRNA vaccine (Pfizer or Moderna)** for your first dose, you should get an mRNA vaccine for your second dose to become fully vaccinated, but it doesn't need to be the same brand. Both Pfizer and Moderna are considered interchangeable so book the first appointment available.

Youth ages 12 to 17 must receive the Pfizer vaccine for both doses.  
Book your second dose 4 weeks after your first dose.

If you received **AstraZeneca** for your first dose, you can choose either the AstraZeneca vaccine or an mRNA vaccine (Pfizer/Moderna) for your second dose.

Both options will provide additional protection and count as completing your immunization in Canada. International jurisdictions may have different standards for a complete immunization series.

Book your second dose 8 weeks after your first dose of AstraZeneca.

95% of new Covid-19 cases are in those that are not vaccinated, or within 2 weeks of first dose.  
92% of those hospitalized with Covid-19 are not vaccinated, or within 2 weeks of first dose.
