Updates to the Restrictions Exemption Program starting today:

- New AB COVID Records Verifier App is available for free download on the "Apple App" or "Google Play" or "Android" Stores.
- Also available online by visiting alberta.ca/covidrecords
- No need to create an account – Alberta Health Care number is required
- The App does not store personal information, all information is stored within the unique QR Code
- Encourage all Albertans to get vaccinated as soon as possible

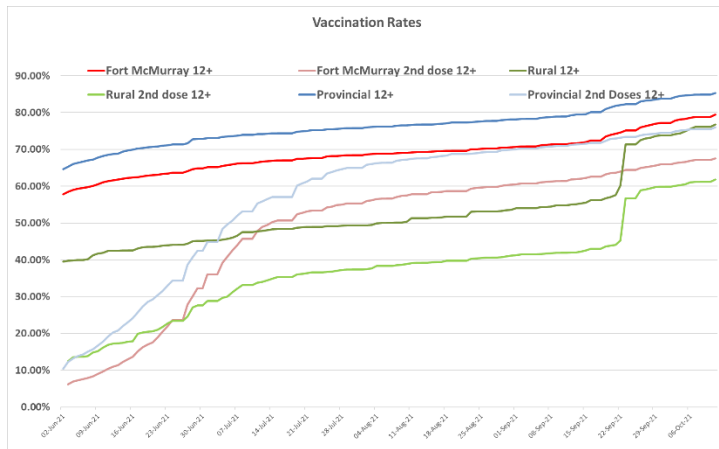
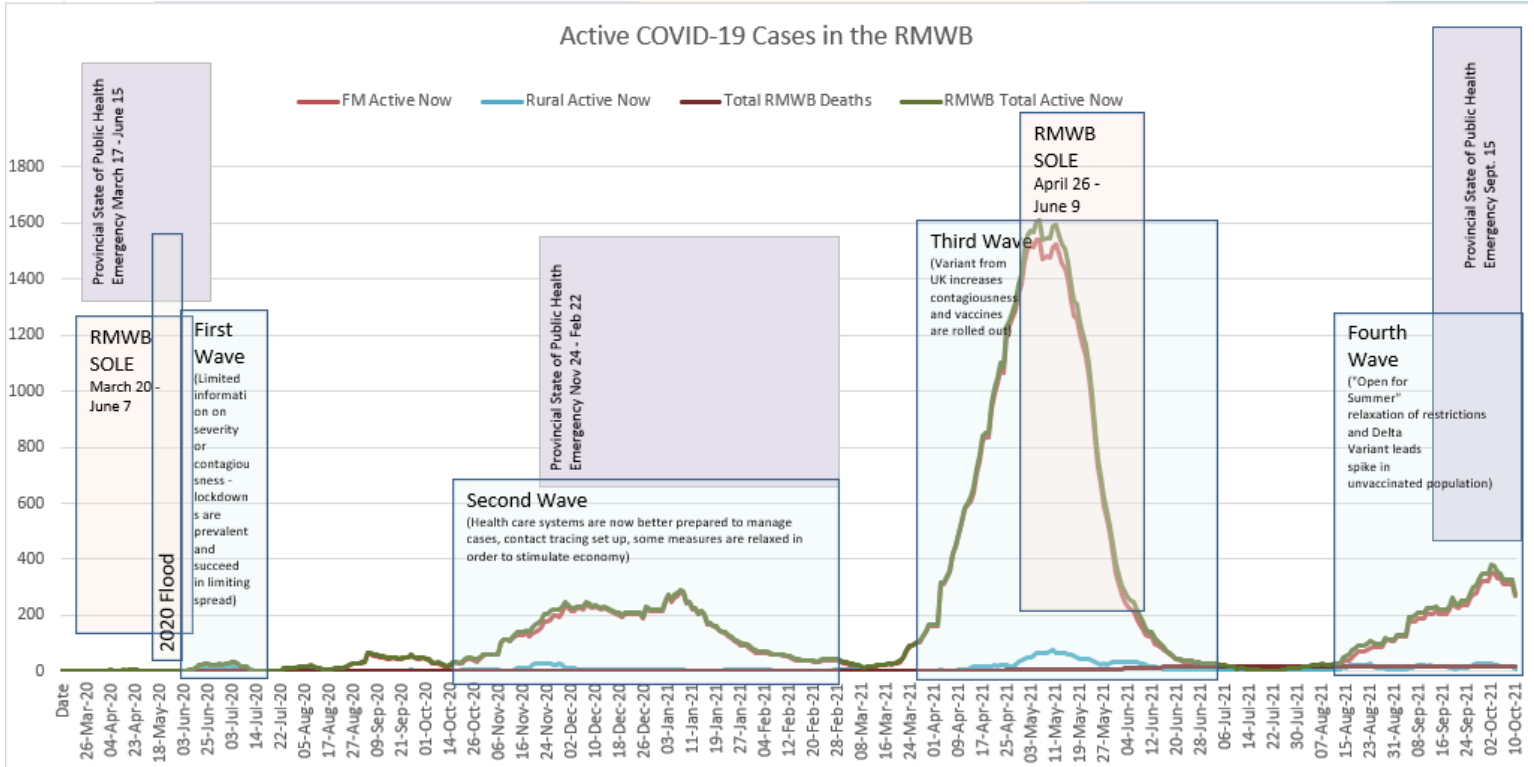
Health Minister Copping demonstrated the fast use of the AB COVID Records Verifier App.

- The app only displays the Name, Date of Birth, and Vaccination Record
- Can download, take a screenshot, or print
- This is a new version of vaccination record – Starting Monday, November 15th, this will be the only acceptable proof of vaccination in Alberta.
- Participants in the REP will be able to scan the QR Code and immediately see Vaccination status
