disease; and

WHEREAS the MS Society's Fort McMurray Regional Office also works to raise awareness

about MS and enhance access to the care and treatments people living with MS

need and deserve; and

WHEREAS funds raised through the annual Fort McMurray Jayman BUILT MS Walk not only

fuel local services, but also contribute to Canadian MS research in finding a cause,

cure and improved treatments; and

WHEREAS multiple sclerosis is the most common neurological disease affecting young adults

in Canada, and Alberta has one of the highest rates of MS in the country, with 14,000

Albertans living with the disease; and

WHEREAS the Saline Creek Bridge will be lit in red in support of this occasion.
