
## *PROCLAMATION*

- WHEREAS** the Municipality must re-establish its population baseline since the 2016 Horse River Wildfire to accurately project expected changes in the population of the region; and
- WHEREAS** the Municipality requires reliable data to plan for capital expenditures and to provide services reflective of the population size of the region; and
- WHEREAS** it has been deemed appropriate to conduct a 2018 municipal census that urges the participation of all residents.
