WELCOME TO RMWB TRANSIT!

This student transit guide has tips on how to get the full benefit of public transit and how to Ride the Right Way. Read on to learn more about Transit routes, safety, bus fares and more.

YOUR KEY TO FORT MCMURRAY

There are numerous buses that regularly stop at Keyano throughout the day, every day. These buses can take you anywhere in Fort McMurray in an hour or less, including connections. Buses that service the Keyano campus include Routes 7, 8, 10, 11, 91 and 92. Route 11a is also available (on grade school days only) as well as route 19 to help you get to college!

FINDING YOUR WAY AND TRACKING YOUR BUS



Use Transit App or Google Maps to find your best route. You can check the location of your bus and watch its progress in real time while waiting for your ride.

HOW TRANSFERS WORK

If you are paying with cash or tickets and you need to take more than one bus, ask your bus driver for a transfer. When boarding the next bus, show the transfer to your driver. Transfers are valid for 90 minutes.

Treat others as you would like to be treated.



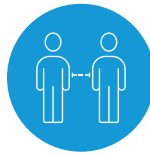
Be respectful and courteous.

Be mindful of the mobility needs of others.

THE FOLLOWING BEHAVIOUR WON'T BE TOLERATED:

- Behaviour that threatens the safety of others or the safe operation of the bus.
- Harassment or discrimination of any kind.
- Vaping, smoking, drinking alcohol or using other drugs.
- Excessive noise or disorderly conduct.
- Vandalizing or creating graffiti on any transit property.

SEE SOMETHING? SAY SOMETHING! REPORT INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOUR OR ACTIONS

If you see inappropriate behaviour while on board - report it to your driver. If it's an emergency, always call 9-1-1.

Can't speak to the driver or want to report a non-emergency incident? Call Pulse at 780-743-7000 and give the date, time and route along with details of the situation.
