- If the artist wishes to promote the exhibition on social media channels outside of the ones used by MacDonald Island Park and the RRCWB, they will ensure that the name of the gallery is written as **Kirschner Family Community Art Gallery**.

DISCLAIMER

- The MacDonald Island Community Art Gallery is in a public facility with basic security (periodic patrols by staff, security cameras) and is NOT supervised.
