Permits

You'll need the following permits:

- Building permit
- Electrical permit
- Gas permit (If using a heater)

You can combine the pool and the deck under one permit or apply separately.

Make sure you consider drainage when building your above-ground pool to maintain structural integrity and prevent water damage.

Rules for outdoor pools:

The entire area of an outdoor swimming pool must be fully enclosed to prevent unauthorized access.

The height of the enclosure must be more than:

 1.8 m for a private swimming pool, and 2.0 m for all other swimming pools (above the outside ground level).

The fence must have a gate which is:

- the same height as the fence
- equipped with a self-closing and self-latching device
- capable of being locked

Inspections

Inspections are required on all permits and must be compliant. You will receive all inspection reports.
