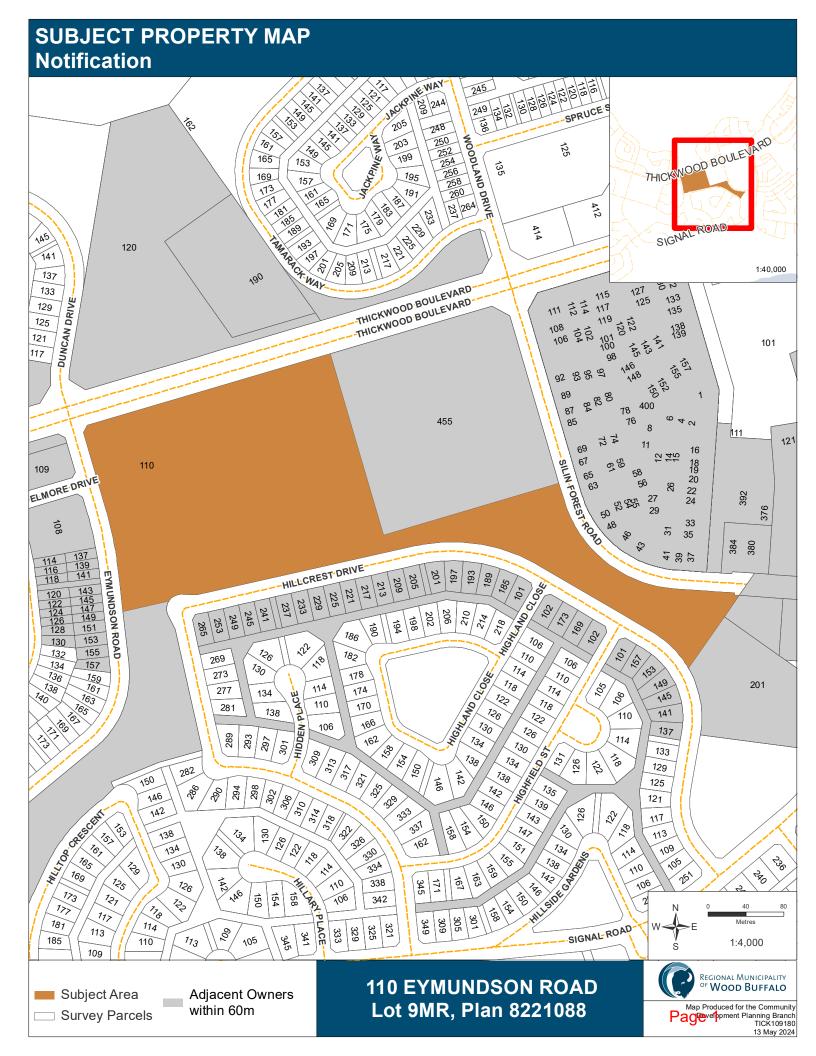

Your application for a development permit at the above location has been approved by the Development Officer. This approval is subject to the conditions as outlined in the enclosed Development Permit.

PLEASE READ PERMIT CONDITIONS CAREFULLY AND RETURN A SIGNED COPY TO OUR OFFICE.

This development permit shall expire and no longer be valid after one year from the date of decision of the permit if no construction has been initiated. Any other necessary permits shall be in place prior to commencement of any construction or occupancy. In the case of a change of use within an existing structure, where no significant construction of reconstruction is necessary, the applicant shall have the new use in operation within one year of the decision of the development permit.

IMPORTANT NOTE

- 1. Under the Municipal Government Amendment Act, this approval may be appealed within twenty one (21) days after the day of decision being posted. Should this decision be appealed within twenty one (21) days after the Date of Decision, this permit shall not become effective until the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board has determined the appeal and the Permit may be modified or nullified thereby. Commencement of the approved Development prior to expiry of the appeal period is at your own risk.
- 2. An appeal shall contain statement of the grounds of appeal and shall be delivered personally or by registered mail so as to reach the Secretary of the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board, 9909 Franklin Avenue, Fort McMurray, AB T9H 2K4 within the prescribed time period of twenty one (21) days.
- 3. Upon delivery of Notice of Appeal, the appellant shall pay to the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo, where the appellant is the owner of the site, or his agent, a fee of \$500.00.

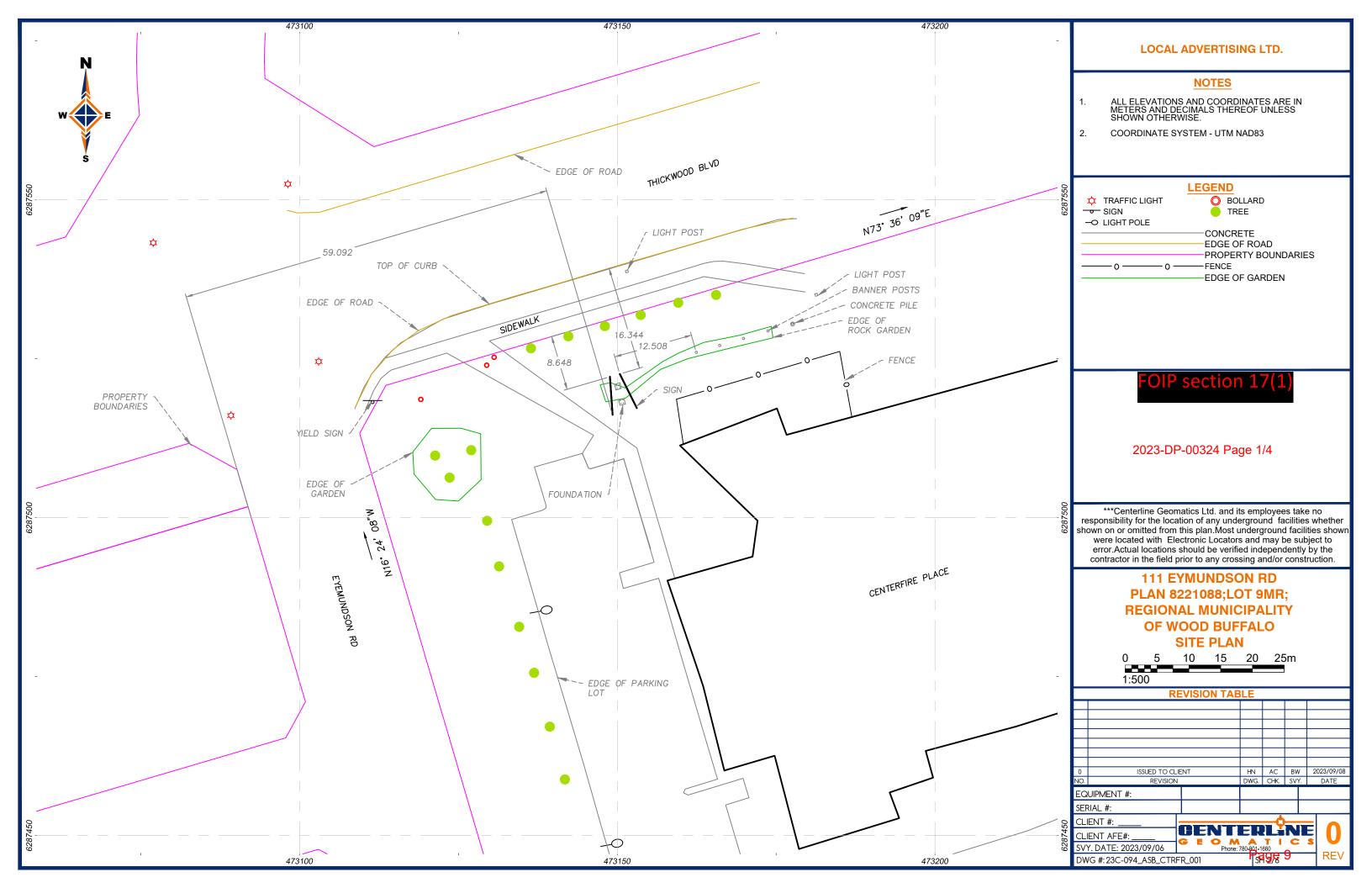
Any damage to the streets, sidewalks, curbs or landscaped boulevards caused by this development shall be the full responsibility of the applicant to restore.

- The Alberta Fire Code applies in and around buildings existing or being constructed on a site. Complete project plans and specifications, construction fire safety plans, and fire related activities requiring Fire Prevention Permits shall be reviewed by the Fire Authority prior to the commencement of any work related thereto. Inquiries and permit applications shall be submitted to the Fire Authority.
- All Federal, Provincial and Municipal Statues and regulations shall be met, including the Alberta Building Code.
- For all Sign Applications for Digital Signs, the Development Officer shall review the application in context with the surrounding development, such as (but not limited to): the architectural theme of the area; any historic designations; the requirements of any Statutory Plan; any streetscape improvements; proximity to residential development; driver decision points; and traffic conflict points. The Development Officer may require application revisions to mitigate the impact of the proposed Sign, and may refuse a permit that adversely impacts the built environment.
- Photovoltaic cells, solar panels, or solar collectors and ancillary equipment may be part of the Sign structure in order to provide electrical power solely to the Copy Area. Photovoltaic cells, solar panels, or solar collectors and ancillary equipment may extend above the maximum Sign Height to the satisfaction of the Development Officer. It must be demonstrated that the additional Height is required to achieve sufficient solar exposure to provide electrical power to the Sign.
- There are existing ATCO Gas facilities in the area. Drainage for any of ATCO Gas above ground appurtenances must be maintained. If it should be necessary to lower, relocate or make any alterations to the existing facilities and/or appurtenances due to this project, please contact ATCO Gas Distribution Engineer Abhinav Badoni(Abhinav.Badoni@ATCO.com, 587-598-1360) to enable an adequate and timely response by ATCO Gas. Note all alteration costs will be borne by the developer / owner.
 - Please contact Utility Safety Partners at 1-800-242-3447 to have the gas lines located at least 48 hours prior to excavation.
 - Deep Utilities: Maintain a minimum of 0.3m vertical clearance and a 2.0m horizontal clearance between ATCO Gas distribution gas lines and your facilities.
 - All Other Facilities: Maintain a minimum of 0.3m vertical clearance and a 1.0m horizontal clearance between ATCO Gas distribution gas lines and your facilities.
 - Above Ground Facilities: Maintain a 1.5m horizontal clearance between ATCO Gas's distribution gas lines and your above ground facilities.
 - If deviations are required please contact Abhinav Badoni (Abhinav.Badoni@ATCO.com, 587-598-1360)
 - Clearance requirements from ATCO Gas pipelines for trees are as follows:
 - minimum of 1 meter from tree spade (hand expose the pipeline)
 - if work must be carried out on a line with trees above it, the trees must be removed
 - to minimize damage, root balls should clear the buried pipeline by 1.2 meters
 - shrubs may be planted in gas rights-of-ways, but trees are not permitted to be planted on gas rights-of-way

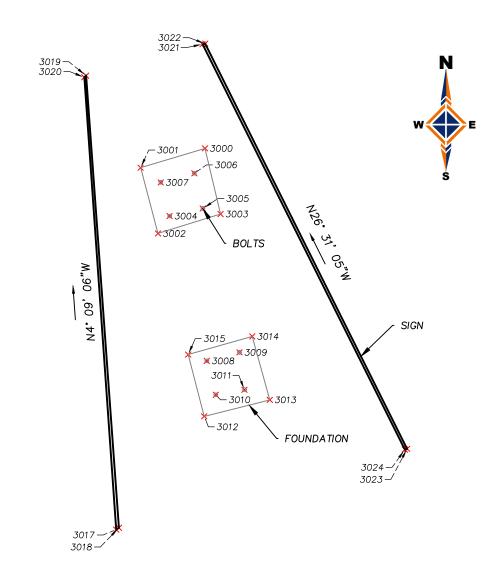
Conditions:

- Digital Signs shall be located such that the Sign does not obscure a driver decision point. The Development Officer shall be satisfied that each Copy Area:
 - i. does not physically obstruct the sightlines or view of a traffic control device or traffic control signal for oncoming vehicle traffic;
 - ii. is not located in the field of view near or past the traffic control device or traffic control signal in the sightlines of coming vehicle traffic;
 - iii. is not located in the field of view near or past other traffic conflict points such as intersections, merge points, exit ramps, or curved roadways, and
 - iv. Illumination does not compete with or dull the contrast of the traffic control device or traffic control signal for oncoming vehicle traffic.
- Digital Signs shall be located or constructed such that Sign Illumination shall not project onto any surrounding residential premises, shall not face an abutting or adjacent Residential Use, and shall not face a Hospital to the satisfaction of the Development Officer.
- The intensity of exposed bulbs on a Sign, excluding Digital Signs, shall not exceed 1,100 lumens.
- Digital Signs shall use automatic light level controls to adjust light levels at night, under cloudy and other darkened conditions to reduce light pollution, in accordance with the following:
 - i. ambient light monitors shall automatically adjust the brightness level of the Copy Area based on ambient light conditions. Brightness levels shall not exceed 0.3 footcandles above ambient light conditions when measured from the Sign Face as its maximum brightness, between sunset and sunrise, at those times determined by the Sunrise/Sunset calculator from the National Research Council of Canada;
 - ii. Brightness level of the Sign shall not exceed 400 nits when measured from the Sign Face at its maximum brightness, between sunset and sunrise, at those times determined by the Sunrise/Sunset calculator from the national research Council of Canada; and
 - iii. Signs abutting or adjacent to natural areas or public parks shall be de-energized daily between 12:00 AM 5:00 AM.
 - iv. Signs abutting or adjacent to residential developments shall be de-energized daily between 12:00 AM 5:00 AM.
- This billboard sign is valid until the same time as the authorization for use of land expire. Should the operating agreement with the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo be cancelled, revoked, or expire, then this development permit will expire.
 - When a development permit expires, a new application is required together with the required fee. Such application shall be dealt with as a first application and there is no obligation to approve an application on the same basis that a previous development permit as been issued.
- The billboard sign is valid for a period of 5 years from the date of issuance of this permit. This permit will expire on November 27, 2028.
- 7 This development is classified as a Billboard Sign and is a Discretionary Use in the DC-PR (Direct Control Parks and Recreation) District.
- 8 Construction materials, including garbage, shall be stored so as to not create a nuisance to neighbouring properties.
- The sign shall be located, oriented and shielded so as to restrict the unneccessary illuminations of adjacent properties.
- The location, size, shape and materials used to contruct the sign shall conform to the approved plans submitted as part of this permit. Any changes to the approved plans shall be submitted to the Development Officer for further approval even if said changes are minor in nature and are consistent with the regulations applied to the site.
- Signs advertising an activity, business, product or service no longer conducted on the premises where the sign is located, shall be removed.

Introduction

- 1. This appeal stems from the approval of Development Permit 2023-DP-00324, an application for a development permit to install a Billboard Sign at 110 Eymundson Road, legally described as Lot 9MR, Plan 822 1088 (the "Subject Property"). A map showing the location of the Subject Property is available as **Attachment 1.**
- The Development Permit was issued pursuant to section 114A of Land Use Bylaw 99/059 (the "LUB") and Bylaw Amendment No. 23/013 by the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo (the "RMWB") Development Authority (the "Development Authority"). (Attachment 2).

Chronology

- 1. January 5, 2023, Application submitted to re-district the Subject Property from PR Parks and Recreation District to DC-PR Direct Control Parks and Recreation District to facilitate the development of a billboard sign on the Subject Property. (Attachment 3).
- 2. August 30, 2023, Planning and Development issued a stop order at 110 Eymundson Road for a freestanding digital sign. Planning and Development determined that a new development permit was required as a new set of sign faces were installed on the existing foundation and support structure and work exceeded maintenance of the approved sign. (Attachment 4).
- 3. September 12, 2023, RMWB Council approved the amendment to re-district the Subject Property from PR Parks and Recreation to the newly created DC-PR Direct Control

Parks and Recreation which allowed for the development of billboard signage on site as a discretionary use. (Attachment 3).

- 4. On September 14, 2023, Planning and Development received the application for a Billboard Sign located at 110 Eymundson Road.
- 5. As part of the review process for the development permit application, on September 20, 2023, additional information was requested from the applicant with no response.
- 6. October 3, 2023, a reminder was sent to the applicant with the request for additional information.
- 7. October 18, 2023, the application was assigned to a planner for planning review and circulation of proposed application to internal and external stakeholders for comments. The circulation period was a standard two-week circulation.
- 8. October 23, 2023, the application was refused by the RMWB Engineering Department. Additional information regarding the foundation and additional engineered documents.
- 9. November 1, 2023, Safety Codes refused the application, requesting additional structural and engineered documents. (**Attachment 5**).
- 10. November 10, 2023, first circulation period closes. Comments were provided to applicant and additional engineering documents were requested.
- 11. February 6, 2024, additional documents submitted by applicant and circulated by Development Authority to Engineering and Safety Codes.
- 12. February 6, 2024, Safety Codes refuses revised documents, the new submitted documents were still missing key information. (**Attachment 5**).
- 13. April 2, 2024, revised documents submitted for review and circulation.
- 14. April 5, 2024, revised documents approved by RMWB Engineering Department.
- 15. April 9, 2024, revised documents approved by RMWB Safety Codes Department.
- 16. April 10, 2024, development permit is approved by Development Authority, permit is issued to applicant for Billboard Sign. (**Attachment 2**).
- 17. Advertising date set for April 18, 2024 to May 9, 2024, including letters to adjacent property owners. (**Attachment 6**).

Summary Discussion

- 18. The Subject property is in the DC-PR Direct Control Parks and Recreation District.
- 19. The DC-PR District was approved by the RMWB Council September 12, 2023.

- 20. The subject signage was reviewed using section 162 (Urban Freestanding Sign Regulations) of the 99/059 Land Use Bylaw. The proposed digital signage met the regulations of section 162 and was approved. (**Attachment 7**).
- 21. The subject Billboard was issued under the 99/059 signage regulations, prior to the adoption of the new signage regulations, Bylaw No. 24/002.
- 22. Prior to amendment No. 24/002, Billboard signs were defined as a sign supported by one or more uprights, braces or pylons, which stands independently of a building and may or may not contain advertising copy related to the development within the parcel upon which the billboard sign is located; (**Attachment 8**).
- 23. Billboard signs are a discretionary use in the DC-PR Direct Control Parks and Recreation District (Land Use Bylaw No.99/059 and Bylaw Amendment No. 23/013)
- 24. The subject Billboard Sign was a new digital sign face placed onto an existing freestanding sign foundation, previously approved as 2013-DP-01155. (**Attachment 9**).
- 25. The subject Billboard Sign was first approved in 1985 as development permit 85/352 for static freestanding sign. (**Attachment 10**).
- 26. All comments from internal and external stakeholders addressed, including engineered sign plans. (**Attachment 5**).

Development Authority's Position

- 27. As per section 156.16(h) of Land Use Bylaw 99/059 the Development Authority identified that illumination from the proposed digital sign may be objectionable to neighbouring residential properties and implemented the following conditions as part of the development permit:
- 28. Condition 2 of the approved development permit Digital signs shall be located or constructed such that Sign Illumination shall not project onto any surrounding residential premises, shall not face an abutting or adjacent Residential Use, and shall not face a hospital to the satisfaction of the Development Officer
- 29. Condition 4 of the approved development permit Digital Signs shall use automatic light level controls to adjust light levels at night, under cloudy and other darkened conditions to reduce light pollution, in accordance with the following:
 - a. Ambient light monitors shall automatically adjust the brightness level of the Copy Area based on ambient light conditions. Brightness levels shall not exceed 0.3 footcandles above ambient light conditions when measured from the Sign Face as its maximum brightness, between sunset and sunrise, at those times

- determined by the Sunrise/Sunset calculator from the National Research Council of Canada;
- b. Brightness level of the Sign shall not exceed 400 nits when measured from the Sign Face at its maximum brightness, between sunset and sunrise, at those times determined by the Sunrise/Sunset calculator from the national research Council of Canada; and
- c. Signs abutting or adjacent to natural areas or public parks shall be de-energized daily between 12:00 AM 5:00 AM.
- d. Signs abutting or adjacent to residential developments shall be de-energized daily between 12:00 AM 5:00 AM.

A BYLAW OF THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF WOOD BUFFALO TO AMEND LAND USE BYLAW NO. 99/059

WHEREAS Section 640 of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, c. M-26 requires Council both to pass and amend Land Use Bylaw No. 99/059;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. Land Use Bylaw No. 99/059 is hereby amended by re-designating Lot 9MR, Plan 822 1088 from PR Parks and Recreation District, to DC-PR Direct Control Parks and Recreation District as depicted on Attachment "2"
- 2. Inserting the attached Schedule A Direct Control Parks and Recreation District as Section 114A.
- 3. Deleting Appendix B Sign Districts Chart: Urban Service Area to Part 7B of the Land Use Bylaw and replacing it with the following:

SCHEDULE A

114A. Direct Control – Parks and Recreation (DC-PR)

114A.1 Purpose

The purpose of this District is to establish special land use and development regulations to accommodate the development of land for parks and recreational facilities intended for the use and enjoyment of the public at large. The District is intended to provide the Municipality with the necessary control over the nature and location, site design and appearance of development on the site. As a Direct Control District, Council may approve any development for any use on any terms and conditions it considers appropriate.

114A.2 Permitted Uses – Development Officer

- (a) Accessory Building
- (b) Park
- (c) Parking Lot/Structure
- (d) Public Utility/Use

114A.3 Discretionary Uses – Council

*Council may approve additional developments at their discretion, where those developments, in Council's view, are compatible with or enhance the existing or proposed developments for the lands within the District.

- (a) Community Recreation Facility
- (b) Outdoor Recreation Facility
- (c) Project Accommodation
- (d) Spectator Sport Facility
- (e) Recyclable Materials Drop-Off Center
- (f) Resort Facility

114A.4 Site Provisions

In addition to the General Regulations contained in Part 5, the following standards shall apply to every development in this district.

- (a) Front Yard (minimum): 6.0 m, except 41.0 m when the site is adjacent to the primary or secondary highway
- (b) Side Yard (minimum): 6.0 m
- (c) Rear Yard (minimum): 6.0 m
- (d) Building Height (maximum): 12.2 m for Principal Building

No. 99/059 (the "LUB")

As a Development Authority for the Municipality, I, Brett Williamson, am hereby issuing this **STOP ORDER** pursuant to Section 645 of the *Municipal Government Act*, with respect to the aforementioned Lands. Our records indicate that the Northern Alberta Athletic Association ("NAAA") is the operator of the building and the associated adjacent legal parcel upon which a Freestanding (Identification) digital sign is located (the "Lands").

Section 645(1) of the *Municipal Government Act* and Section 37.4 of the LUB permit a Development Officer (as Development Authority) to issue a **Stop Order** directing the owner to stop the use of the land or building in whole or in part where development or use of the land or building does not comply with the *Municipal Government Act*, the Land Use Bylaw, a Development Permit, or a Subdivision Approval.

In this STOP ORDER:

- "MGA" means the Municipal Government Act of the Province of Alberta.
- "Municipality" means the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo.
- "Lands" means the lands legally described as follows: Lot 9MR, Plan 822 1088
- "LUB" means Bylaw 99/059, the Municipality's Land Use Bylaw.

This **STOP ORDER** concerns unauthorized developments and uses on the Lands contrary to the LUB and the MGA.

The MGA provides that no person shall undertake a development contrary to a Land Use Bylaw. Section 19 of the LUB provides that a person shall only undertake development if a development permit has first been issued unless otherwise provided by the LUB. Further, the MGA and LUB provide that on finding that a development or land use is not in accordance with the MGA or LUB,

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a Development Authority may issue a written order to stop the development or use of the land in whole or in part as directed, demolish, remove, or replace the development, or carry out any other actions required so that the development or use of the land or building complies with the MGA or LUB.

TAKE NOTICE THAT the following issues with respect to the Freestanding (identification) digital sign on the Land are contrary to the LUB:

- 1. That an inspection has confirmed that the Freestanding Digital Sign approved pursuant to 2013-DP-01155 has been removed and replaced by a new sign (the "New Development");
- 2. The New Development is not mere "maintenance" as contemplated by section 156.5 of the LUB, but is a completely new installation, with all components of the previously approved "Freestanding sign" having been replaced, other than the concrete footings and two tower pedestal poles connecting the sign structure to the footings;
- 3. The New Development has not been approved in accordance with section 19.1 of the LUB.

The New Development has been completed without obtaining the necessary permissions to complete this work. This New Development is hereby in contravention of the following:

- 1. Land Use Bylaw section 19.1 which states that: "Except as otherwise provided in this Bylaw, no person shall undertake any development in the Municipality unless a development permit has first been issued pursuant to this Bylaw, and the development is in accordance with the terms and conditions of a development permit issued pursuant to this Bylaw."
 - [Development Authority no development permit has been issued for the New Development.]
- 2. Land Use Bylaw section 19.2 which states that: "In addition to meeting the requirements of this Bylaw, it is the responsibility of the applicant to obtain other such approvals or licenses that may be required by other regulatory departments or agencies." [Development Authority evidence has not been provided of any authorizations required as part of the Centerfire Place operating agreement.]
- 3. Land Use Bylaw section 156.5 which states that" Except as otherwise provided for in Part 7B, no person shall develop, construct, erect, paint, enlarge, relocate or structurally alter any sign on any property, other than for general maintenance, without first obtaining the permission of the Development Officer through the issuance of a development permit."
 - [Development Authority the existing sign copy area and box enclosure approved pursuant to 2013-DP-01155 has been removed and replaced with two new sign panels. These panels are fastened to the supporting pedestal poles by new supporting hardware and infrastructure. There are now two distinguishable sign copy panels, no longer set at a 90-degree orientation to the adjacent Thickwood Boulevard. The approved panel copy size area was 10 feet x 20 feet (200 square feet) for each panel. The New Development copy area is unknown. Electrical conduit and connections for the New Development may have been replaced as well.]

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- 4. Development permit 2013-DP-01155, condition #2: "The location, size, shape and materials used to construct the sign shall conform to the approved plans submitted as part of this permit. Any changes to the approved plans shall be submitted to the Development Officer for further approval even if said changes are minor in nature and are consistent with the regulations applied to the site."
 [Development Authority emphasis added.]
- 5. Development permit 2013-DP-01155, condition #6: "The sign shall be located, oriented and shielded so as to restrict the unnecessary illuminations of adjacent properties." [Development Authority as noted above, the orientation of the copy area for both sign panels in the New Development has changed and requires prior approval by the Development Authority.]
- Development permit 2013-DP-01155, condition #7: "Digital Signs shall be located or constructed such that Sign Illumination shall not project onto any surrounding residential premises."
 - [Development Authority The existing freestanding signage has been altered, and illumination is unknown. Approval by the Development Authority is required.]
- 7. Development permit 2013-DP-01155, condition #8: "The intensity of exposed bulbs on a Sign, excluding Digital Signs, shall not exceed 1,100 lumens.
 - [Development Authority a new development permit is required to review and approve the brightness of the new digital signage.]
- 8. Development permit 2013-DP-01155, condition #9: "Illumination does not compete with or dull the contrast of the traffic control device or traffic control signal for oncoming vehicle traffic."
 - [Development Authority permit required to review the new digital signage to ensure that it does not constitute a traffic hazard.]
- 9. Development permit 2013-DP-01155, condition #10: "Digital Signs shall use automatic light level controls to adjust light levels at night, under cloudy and other darkened conditions to reduce light pollution, in accordance with the following:
 - a. ambient light monitors shall automatically adjust the brightness level of the Copy Area based on ambient light conditions. Brightness levels shall not exceed 0.3 footcandles above ambient light conditions when measured from the Sign Face at its maximum brightness, between sunset and sunrise, at those times determined by the Sunrise / Sunset calculator from the National Research Council of Canada:
 - b. Brightness level of the Sign shall not exceed 400 nits when measured from the Sign Face at its maximum brightness, between sunset and sunrise, at those times determined by the Sunrise/Sunset calculator from the national research Council of Canada; and
 - c. Signs abutting or adjacent to natural areas or public parks shall be de-energized daily between 12:00 AM 5:00 AM.

[Development Authority – new permit is required to review the New Development and associated digital signage for compatibility with adjacent land uses.]

It is hereby ordered that the use of the "Freestanding digital sign" located on the pedestal formerly associated with the sign approved by 2013-DP-01155 be immediately stopped and the following action taken:

- 1. That the said digital sign(s) (the New Development) be de-energized and not reenergized until such time as a new development permit for the said use has been issued and released;
- 2. That the site upon which the sign is situated is subject to a current land use amendment application. Should Council **not approve** the proposed land use amendment for the subject site, to be considered on (or after) Tuesday September 12, 2023, that either:
 - a. the non-compliant sign be removed forthwith; or
 - b. a new development permit application for a Freestanding (Identification) Sign be submitted within 14 days following such Council decision and that such application be pursued actively by said applicant.
- 3. That, in the alternative, should Council **approve** the proposed land use amendment for the subject site, to be considered on (or after) Tuesday September 12, 2023, that a development permit application for a lawful sign in that new district (i.e. either a digital Freestanding (Billboard) sign or digital Freestanding (Identification) sign) be submitted in "complete" form within 14 days following such Council approval and that such application be pursued actively by said applicant;
- 4. That should any form of development permit application for a replacement sign not be issued and released by February 12, 2024 that the existing non-compliant sign (New Development only, not the pedestal poles or concrete foundation) will be removed forthwith; and
- 5. That the approved sign that was located on the site pursuant to 2013-DP-01155 not be relocated or replaced on the site without a new development permit being issued and released.

BE ADVISED that pursuant to Section 646 of the *Municipal Government Act* the Municipality has the authority, in the event that any requirements of this Order are not complied with, within the time limits provided, to take whatever actions or measures are determined by the Municipality to be necessary. This may include all or any of the following:

- to enter on the subject Land pursuant to Section 542 of the *Municipal Government Act* and to take any action necessary to carry out this **Stop Order**.
- seeking an injunction or other relief from the Alberta Court of King's Bench pursuant to Section 554 of the *Municipal Government Act*.
- Further the Municipality has the authority to add the costs and expenses of carrying out this Order to the tax roll of <u>any property</u> for which you are the assessed person pursuant to Section 553.1(1)(c) of the *Municipal Government Act*.

Please be advised that pursuant to Section 686 of the *Municipal Government Act* you may by written notice file a notice of appeal, containing reasons, of the **Stop Order** within twenty-one days of the date of service of the **Stop Order** upon you. 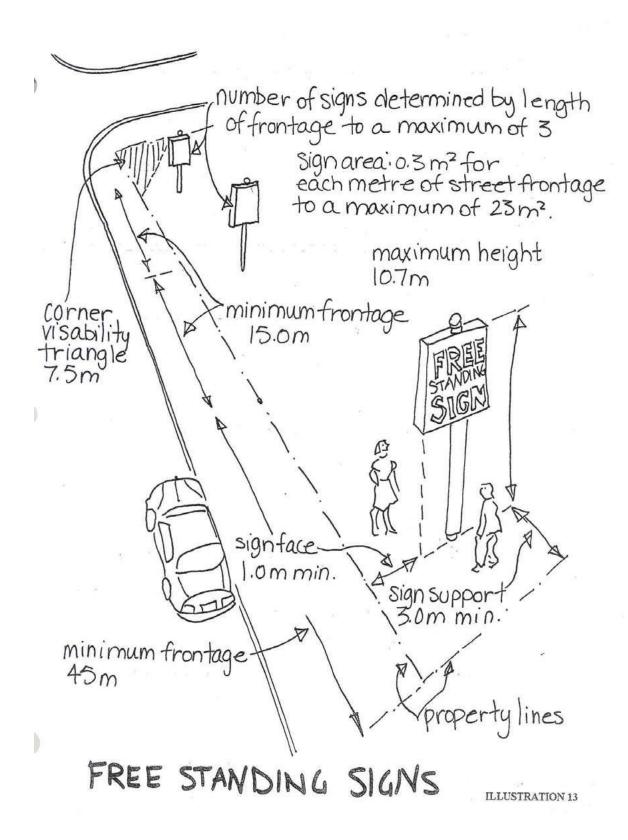

Land Use Bylaw No. 99/059

BANNER SIGN means a sign constructed of non-rigid cloth, plastic or other fabric which is attached at all four corners to a pole, building or other supporting structure and is intended to be of a temporary nature but does not include flags;

BILLBOARD SIGN means a sign supported by one or more uprights, braces or pylons, which stands independently of a building and may or may not contain advertising copy related to the development within the parcel upon which the billboard sign is located;

BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER means any Bylaw Officer appointed by the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo and includes a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police and/or a Special Constable;

CANOPY means a solid non-retractable, projection which extends from the wall of a building for the purpose of affording protection from the weather and includes a structure commonly known as a theatre marquee, but does not include normal architectural features such as lintels, sills, moldings, architraves and pediments;

CANOPY SIGN means a sign attached to or constructed in or on a face of a canopy;

CARRIAGEWAY means that portion of a public roadway intended to carry vehicular traffic. Typically, in urban areas, the carriageway is defined by parallel curb lines;

CHANGEABLE COPY COMPONENT means a portion of a sign on which the copy can be changed automatically, and may include an electric message unit, or manually through the use of attachable letters, numbers or symbols;

CLEARANCE means the vertical distance between the lowest part of a sign and the finished grade;

COMMUNITY NOTICE BOARD means a structure erected by the Municipality for the purpose of posting of temporary notices of community interest;

COMPREHENSIVE SIGN DESIGN PLAN means a coordinated signage design undertaken by one lot owner/developer or the owners/developers of two or more contiguous lots or on multiple tenant properties. Design co-ordination may include, but is not limited to, colour, area, shape, illumination, placement, and copy font size and style;

CONSTRUCTION SITE IDENTIFICATION SIGN means a temporary sign for **providing** information or advertising related to the construction project only, and erected by an individual or firm on the premises undergoing construction;

COPY means the message on the sign face including, but not limited to, words, numbers, logos, **symbols**, and decorations;

COPY AREA means the entire area, which encloses the limits of the message, contained on the sign but excludes the main support structure. For multi or double-faced signs, copy area is **the** area of one face;

CURB EXTENSION means that line which extends from curb return to curb return along the same roadway;

CURB LINE means the line at the face of the nearest curb and in the absence of a curb, the line shall be established by Public Works and Engineering;

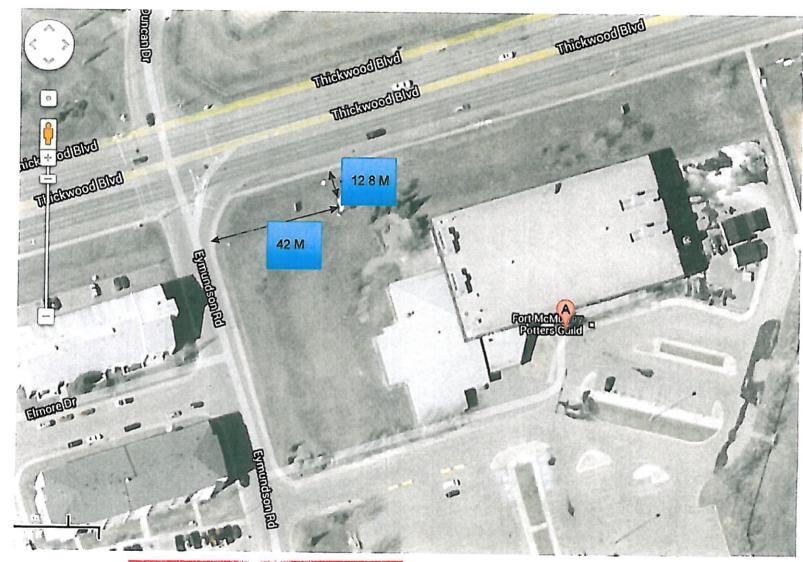

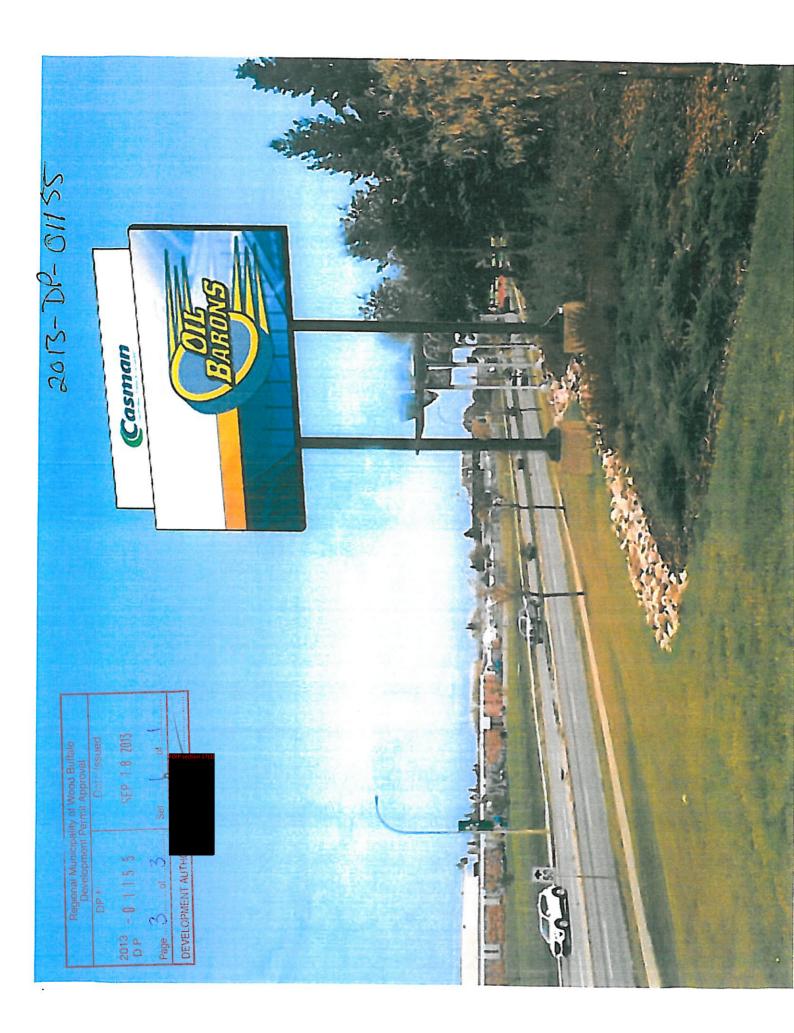

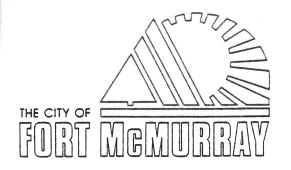

The City's Planning Department has advised that the proposed sign is not in keeping with an appropriate standard for PE Districts, as well as, it exceeds the allowable sign area of 200 square feet maximum. Signs placed in a PE District are considered a discretionary use under the Land Use By-law.

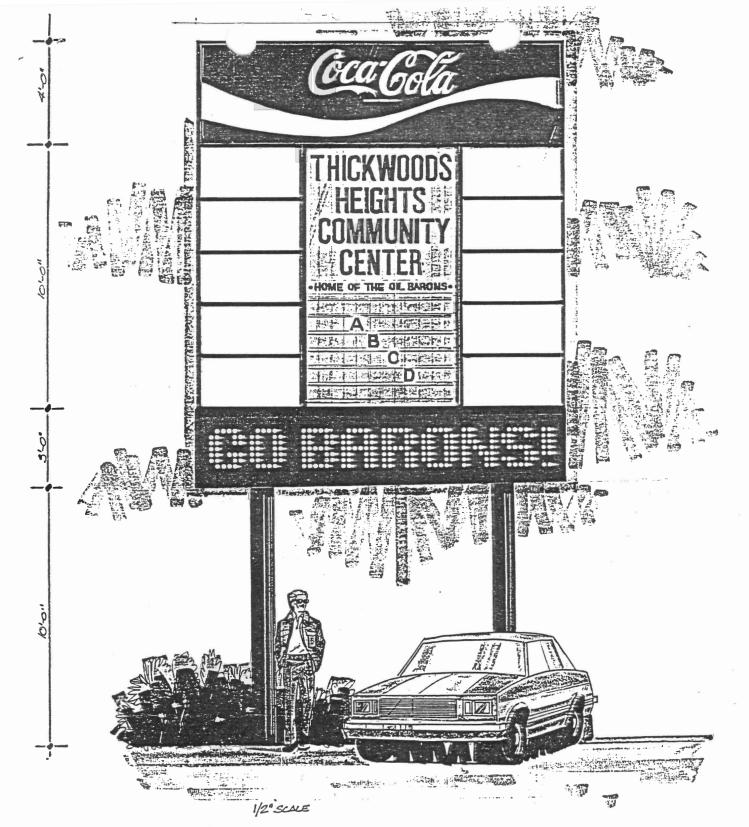
