

Reader's Guide – 2020 Budget Documentation

During the Budget meetings from Nov. 27 – Nov. 30, Council will be reviewing a large number of complex documents. Many of these documents speak to and build upon each other. To help you review this volume of information and follow along with Council, we've outlined some suggested steps for approaching the documentation in a way that is easily accessible. We continue to build the proposed budget using the Zero-Based Budgeting principles, which is a more robust process and therefore provides more detail in the documentation.

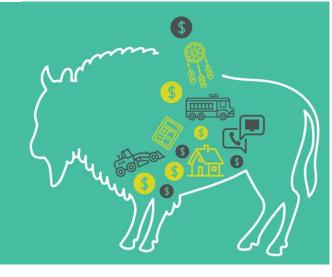
Step 1 – Budget Council Report (Attachment 1 in Council Report)

Before delving into the details of the budget, we encourage you to review the 2020 Budget Council Report listed as item #3 of the Nov. 27 Council Meeting Agenda. This provides a high-level overview of the proposed 2020 budget. Attachment 1 is the 2020 Proposed Operating Budget & 2021 – 2022 Financial Plan.

Step 2 – Corporate Summary (Attachment 2 in Council Report)

The Corporate Summary can be found as Attachment 2 to the Council Report under item #3 of the Nov. 27 Council Meeting Agenda. The Corporate Summary outlines all revenues and expenses from 2020 through each year up to 2022. This summary also provides a breakdown of the 2019 Budget and 2019 Projections.

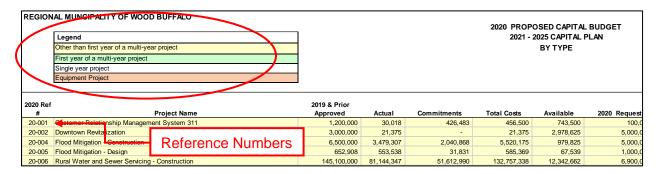

Step 3 – The Rainbow Spreadsheet (Attachment 3 in Council Report)

Attachment #3 consists of multi-coloured (i.e., rainbow) spreadsheets which lists projects for the 2020 Proposed Capital Budget and 2021 – 2025 Capital Plan by Type. In the first column on the left, you will find a Reference Number (2020 Ref#). These reference numbers identify the project and will correspond with the Capital Budget Presentations outlined in Step 7. The rainbow spreadsheet provides a more detailed look at the calculations, while the presentation is a more descriptive look at the proposed projects.

Noting the legend in the top left-hand side of the spreadsheet, this will provide more context as to the meaning of each colour of the rainbow.

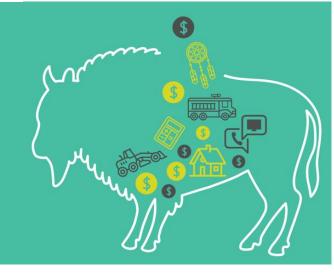


Step 4 – Community Investment Program (CIP)

The Community Investment Program presentation summary is listed under item #4 of the Nov. 27 Council Meeting Agenda. You'll see a list of community organizations that will be making presentations to discuss their funding requests. A copy of each presentation can be found by clicking on the corresponding organization in the Council Agenda.

Step 5 – Operating Budget Presentations

The 2020 Operating Budget presentations are listed under item #3 of the Nov. 28 Council Meeting Agenda. Each presentation provides a high-level overview of the operating budget requests for each department/area. These presentations will also give you an idea of the departmental structure and the programs/services they provide.



Step 6 – Financial Summaries (By Division, Department and Program/Service)

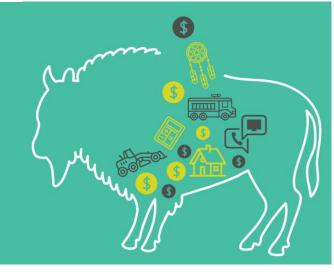
Financial Summaries provide further details on operation costs and program/service details (these are found at the end of each departmental presentation). These documents are colour-coded: department and branch summaries are blue and green, while the program/service details are orange, blue and green. These documents provide a detailed look at operations and associated costs and were developed as part of the Zero-Based Budgeting process.

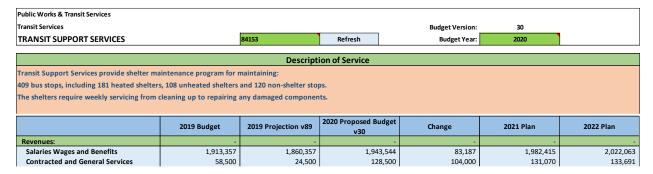

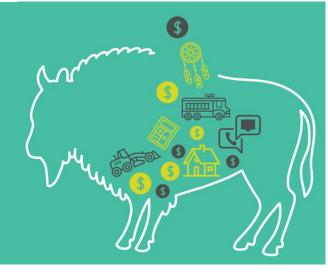


Step 7 - Capital Budget Presentations

Each presentation provides a high-level overview of the capital budget requests for each department/area. These presentations will also give you a high-level overview of the projects Administration is proposing for 2020.

These reference numbers are to help for tracking projects across the Rainbow spreadsheet, the Budget Request Forms and the Departmental Capital Presentations. Please note that projects are not presented in numerical sequence.
