[1] The Chair confirmed with the parties in attendance that there were no objections to the constitution of the Board or the process to be followed.

- [9] In accordance with the requirements laid out in section 686(3) of *the Municipal Government Act* a notice of the hearing will be sent out to all parties. The Board confirms that all evidence can be submitted electronically via email, details of which will be outlined in the notice of hearing.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION


