Response Planning Tips

- Carefully read the entire RFX document and do not assume all RFX documents are the same
- Attend any pre-tender/pre-proposal meeting being conducted [especially if mandatory]
- Clarify any uncertainties prior to the close of question period
- Obtain all addenda and consider the content in your submission
- Ensure your response is submitted prior to the submission deadline via the e-Procurement platform
- Plan to comply with all mandatory requirements
