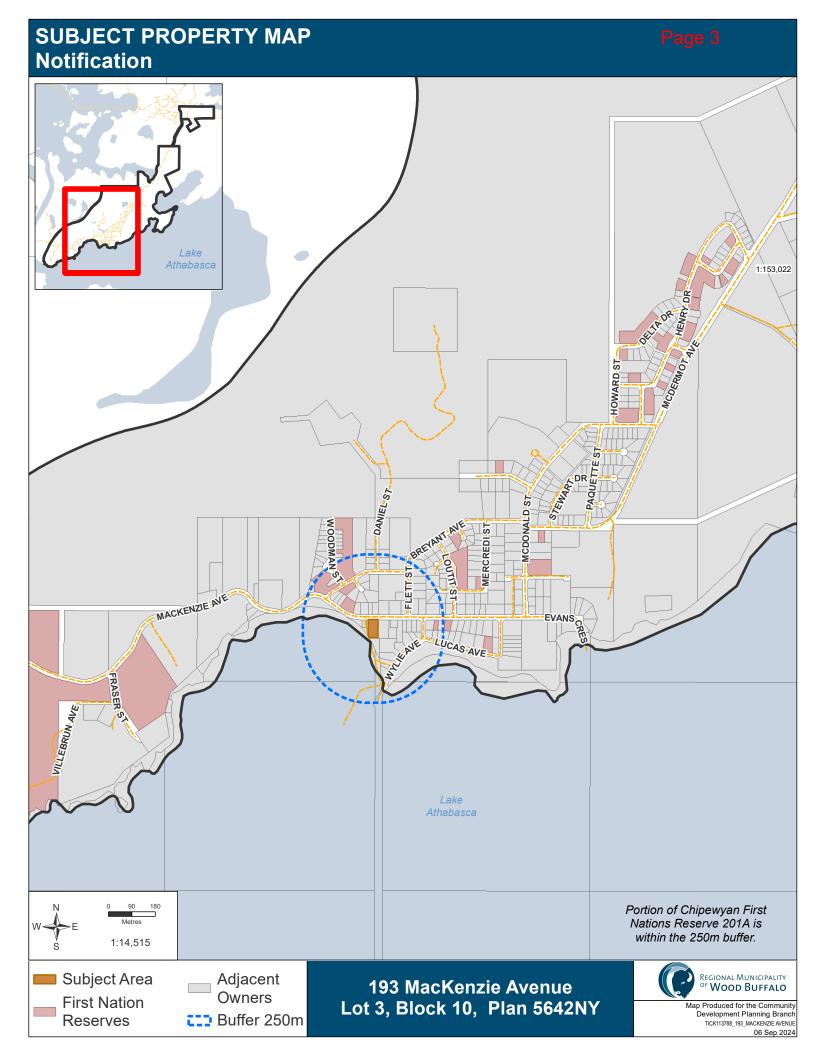

Your application for a development permit at the above location has been approved by the Development Officer. This approval is subject to the conditions as outlined in the enclosed Development Permit.

## PLEASE READ PERMIT CONDITIONS CAREFULLY AND RETURN A SIGNED COPY TO OUR OFFICE.

This development permit shall expire and no longer be valid after one year from the date of decision of the permit if no construction has been initiated. ### **Advisory Notes:**

- Any signage proposed for this development shall require a separate application and approval.
- Any sump required for the development shall be installed so that discharge is as per the requirements of the Sewage Bylaw.
- The developer shall install all appropriate signage at access/egress locations in accordance with the requirements of the Engineering Department.
- 4 Site services shall be in accordance with the Engineering Standards of the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo.
- A Utility Installation Permit is required from the developer and shall be obtained from Engineering Services Division prior to installing underground utilities.
- It shall be the developer's responsibility and expense to terminate, at the main, all sanitary and water services which will not be utilized in this development.
- If a route haul permit is required for this development, it shall be applied for through the Planning and Development Department.
- Any damage to the streets, sidewalks, curbs or landscaped boulevards caused by this development shall be the full responsibility of the developer to restore.
- 9 All required Safety Code permits under the Safety Code Act in the: building, mechanical, electrical, gas, plumbing and private sewage disciplines must be obtained for this development. Please contact the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo Planning and Development Branch to obtain the required Safety Code permits or for information regarding these permits 780-799-8695.
- A Health Certificate may be required for this development. Please contact the Health Inspector for the necessary information.
- A Municipal Business License is required for this development. Please contact the Licensing Enforcement Officer for information and an application.
- The Alberta Fire Code applies in and around buildings existing or being constructed on a site. Complete project plans and specifications, construction fire safety plans, and fire related activities requiring Fire Prevention Permits shall be reviewed by the Fire Authority prior to the commencement of any work related thereto. Inquiries and permit applications shall be submitted to the Fire Authority.
- All Federal, Provincial and Municipal statutes and regulations shall be met, including the Alberta Building Code.

#### Conditions:

- The business must have all valid licenses/approvals from the provincial government prior to starting operations and shall be in compliance with the provincial legislation.
- This development is classified as a Liquor Store, Office and Warehouse and is a Discretionary Use in the HC- Hamlet Commercial District.
- 3 Any temporary or auxiliary buildings/signs placed on site during construction shall be removed prior to occupancy.
- 4 Construction materials, including garbage, shall be stored so as not to create a nuisance to neighbouring properties.
- The garbage and waste material shall be stored in weather-proof and animal-proof containers and shall be visually screened in a manner compatible with the design and external materials of the principal buildings on the site. If a wood screen fence is used, it shall be constructed in accordance with drawing 10-301 of the Engineering Servicing Standards.
- The building location, orientation, capacity and/or use shall be as indicated on the approved drawings. Any changes to the approved plans shall be submitted to the Development Officer for further approval.
- A minimum of 19 on-site parking stalls shall be provided as indicated on the approved plan. All parking stalls shall be hard surfaced with asphalt pavement, concrete or other similar paving material and shall be completed prior to the issuance of an Occupancy Permit. Should a seasonal allowance be required for paving the parking lot, the developer shall provide a written request for the seasonal allowance together with an automatically renewable and irrevocable letter of credit equal to 100 percent of the cost of paving the parking lot. A minimum of 2of the required stalls shall be accessible parking stalls. These parking stalls shall be hard-surfaced, level, located close to an entrance, and shall be designated with the International Symbol of Access.
- A minimum of one loading space shall be provided for this development. Loading shall be designed and located so that all vehicles using those spaces can be parked and maneuvered entirely within the bounds of the site before moving onto adjacent streets or lands.
- 9 All parking stalls shall be graded such that no slope in any direction is less than 0.5% and not more than 4%, to the satisfaction of the Development Officer. All soft landscaped areas shall have a minimum slope of 2% away from buildings.
- A final site grading plan shall be prepared to the satisfaction of the Engineering Department and shall be approved prior to occupancy of any buildings.
- 11 The applicant may need to enter into a Development Agreement with the Municipality to pay for the installation of public utilities, other than telecommunication systems or works, which are necessary to serve the development.
- Any excess fill must be deposited on a site approved by the Municipality. Please contact the Engineering Department and/or the Environmental Branch of the Public Works Department.
- Any and all easements required by the Municipality or any franchise utility as a result of this development shall be provided by the developer at no cost to the Municipality or any franchise utility and shall be registered on title by Utility Right-of-Way Plan.
- Should it be necessary to alter any on site Municipal or franchise utilities, all cost shall be borne by the developer.
- There shall be no unauthorized use of any adjoining Public Utility Lot or Reserve Land during the course of the approved development construction. The developer may apply to the Development Officer to utilize these lands.
- All on site lighting shall be located, oriented and shielded so as to restrict the unnecessary illumination of adjacent residential properties.

- 17 Before any construction starts, the applicant shall ensure that the site is fully fenced, as per the approved fencing plan, in order to prevent any damage to Municipal infrastructure and landscaping surrounding the site, to ensure controlled and safe access and egress of the site, and to provide safe pedestrian access on and through any municipal lands adjacent to the site. The site access locations shall be established as per the fencing plan and will be maintained and operated to the satisfaction of the Development Authority. The fencing is to remain in place and in good working condition until all construction activities have ceased and a Full Development Completion Certificate has been issued.
- Any required removal or modification of existing on-site underground storage tanks and the management of identified contaminants shall be undertaken to the satisfaction of the appropriate authorities prior to the construction of the approved development and all applicable permits received from the local Fire Authority.

- Engineering securities of \$40,000 in total [including (a) \$10,000 for 1 approach, (b) \$20,000 for service connections (\$10,000/water + \$10,000/sanitary each), and (c) \$10,000 for a new storm outfall, shall be provided before issuance of the development permit. This is also a damage deposit for any damage to municipal property including roads, sidewalks, curb and gutter, underground infrastructure, boulevard, parks, URWs. All must be restored to original or better condition.
- 24 Construction activities will be completed in adherence to all environment and regulatory requirements which include, but are not limited to the Federal Fisheries Act and the Provincial Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act. Construction activities will implement effective sediment control measures at all stages of construction until disturbed soil has been addressed and the fish bearing water body is effectively protected from any impacts.

#### Introduction

- 1. This appeal stems from the approval of *Development Permit 2023-DP-00125*, an application for a "Liquor Store, Office and Warehouse Sales" use at 193 MacKenzie Avenue in Fort Chipewyan (Approved Development Permit 2023-DP-00125: Attachment 1), legally described as Lot 3, Block 10, Plan 5642NY, referred to as the "Subject Property" (Subject Property Map: Attachment 2).
- 2. The approval for Development Permit 2023-DP-00125 includes Condition #26, which restricts the operational hours of the liquor store. While Alberta Gaming, Liquor and Cannabis (AGLC) permits retail liquor stores to operate from 9 a.m. to 2 a.m., Monday through Sunday, Condition #26 limits the store's hours from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Sunday.
- 3. Condition #26 states:

The hours of operation for the Liquor Store are limited to 9:00 a.m. -6:00 p.m., Monday to Sunday. Outside the permitted hours of operation, the sale of alcohol or any other products is prohibited, and the premises shall remain closed to the public.

- 4. The proposed uses are Discretionary Uses in the HC- Hamlet Commercial District and within the authority of the Development Officer to approve. Therefore, it is also within the authority of the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board (SDAB) to consider the appeal.
- 5. The approval of Development Permit 2023-DP-00125 was publicized on the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo's (referred to as the "Municipality") website. Approval notifications were distributed to property owners within a 200-meter radius of the Subject Property. Notifications were also provided to the leadership and offices of the

three nations: Athabasca Chipewyan First Nation, the Fort Chipewyan Métis Nation, and Mikisew Cree First Nation. Additionally, notifications were posted at the Fort Chipewyan municipal office and Mamawi Hall.

#### **Chronology**

- 6. On May 1, 2023, the Development Authority received the application for a Liquor Store, Office, and Warehouse Sales.
- 7. On May 3, 2023, the Development Authority began the property file and planning review.
- 8. On May 8, 2023, the Development Authority informed the applicant, Daniel Roy, via his agent, Edward Le Clerc, that the planning review had identified deficiencies in the application. The applicant was instructed to provide the missing or incomplete information necessary to continue processing the Development Permit application.
- 9. Between May 2023 and July 2023, the Development Authority worked with the applicant via his agent to work towards rectifying the deficiencies in the application, which included submitting more detailed drawings and technical information.
- 10. On July 19, 2023, the Development Authority had assessed that it had received all of the missing or incomplete information that was requested.
- 11. On July 21, 2023, the Development Authority informed the applicant that, due to community concerns about alcohol-related issues, the application would undergo a more thorough and extended review process. This process would include enhanced opportunities for community engagement. This extended review process is authorized under Section 17.2(b) of Land Use Bylaw 99/059.
- 12. Section 17.2(b) states that: The Development Officer may:

refer development permit applications to the Municipal Planning Commission for those uses listed as "Permitted Uses" or "Discretionary Uses – Development Officer" which the Development Officer wishes to refer to the Municipal Planning Commission.

Furthermore, Section 17.3 states that:

In the absence of a Municipal Planning Commission, the Development Officer shall perform its duties and responsibilities.

Since the Municipality does not have a Municipal Planning Commission, the Development Officer performed the duties and responsibilities of the Municipal Planning Commission for this Development Permit application.

13. In accordance with Sections 17.2(b) and 17.3 of Land Use Bylaw 99/059, the Development Authority advised the applicant that it intended to solicit feedback from the broader community, including community leadership, in Fort Chipewyan. This process included opportunities for community members to provide feedback before a decision was made. Furthermore, the applicant was also advised that interested

- parties could appeal any decision made by the Development Authority to the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board
- 14. On July 25, 2023, the Development Authority circulated the application to both internal and external reviewers. Notifications were also sent to all property owners within the Fort Chipewyan hamlet boundary, as well as to the offices of the three nations: Athabasca Chipewyan First Nation, the Fort Chipewyan Métis Nation, and Mikisew Cree First Nation. A deadline of August 17, 2023, was provided for residents and reviewers to provide comments. The decision to notify all property owners exceeded the Municipality's standard process but was deemed important and within the discretionary authority of the Development Authority. The normal process is to notify adjacent property owners within a 100-meter radius of a proposed development.
- 15. On August 17, 2023, the Development Authority was notified by the Municipality's Indigenous and Rural Relations Department that community leadership had requested a one-week extension to the August 17, 2023, deadline. This request was granted, and the deadline was moved to August 25, 2023.
- 16. On August 18, 2023, the Development Authority forwarded the comments from internal and external reviewers to the applicant through the applicant's agent. It was emphasized that the comments must be addressed before the application could proceed to the next step of the Development Permit review process. Comments were received from the following internal reviewers: Engineering Department, Safety Codes Services Branch, and Regional Emergency Services Department.
- 17. By August 25, 2023, the Development Authority received 10 letters from individual residents of Fort Chipewyan and one letter from Mikisew Cree First Nation (signed by Chief Tuccaro on behalf of the Nation's membership). Overall, the feedback opposed the development of the liquor store. None of the letters expressed support for the development. Commentors referred to the current issues within the community related to drugs and alcohol, including the escalation of crime in the community.
- 18. Between September 2023 and June 2024, the Development Authority worked with the applicant to address the comments provided by internal and external reviewers. The applicant was advised that the Development Permit application could only be considered complete and proceed to the next stage (rendering a decision) once all comments had been satisfactorily addressed.
- 19. Between December 2023 and February 2024, there was a period during which the applicant was not in communication with the Development Authority. Towards the end of this time period, the applicant notified the Development Authority that his agent was no longer able to fulfill their duties. Consequently, the applicant assumed responsibility for the tasks previously managed by the agent and resumed direct communication with the Development Authority.
- 20. In July 2024, the Development Authority was prepared to render a decision on the Development Permit application, having received all required information requested and that was deemed satisfactory to the reviewers who requested the additional information. The applicant had also submitted the necessary securities to the Municipality.
- 21. The major items that were requested by the reviewers and were addressed by the

applicant were submitting new technical drawings required by Regional Emergency Services, the Engineering Department, and the Safety Codes branch. These technical drawings included revised grading plans, revised building plans, and a revised site plan.

22. On August 16, 2024, the Development Authority approved and issued Development Permit 2023-DP-00125, with Condition #26, which restricted the hours of operations for the Liquor Store.

#### **Discussion**

- 23. The Development Authority determined that there were no justifiable planning reasons to refuse the Development Permit. The Development Permit application is in alignment with planning policies such as the Municipal Development Plan (2011) and the Fort Chipewyan Area Structure Plan (2018), as well as regulations including Land Use Bylaw 99/059.
- 24. Section C.2.4 of the Municipal Development Plan emphasizes the importance of balanced growth in Fort Chipewyan. It states that future development should be encouraged to concentrate near the Community Core and that efforts should be made to direct development into this area to optimize the use of underutilized lands.
- 25. According to the Fort Chipewyan Area Structure Plan, the Subject Property is situated within the designated "Community Core" area. The Community Core is envisioned to be the heart of the Hamlet and a hub for commercial, institutional and residential uses. The Community Core is intended to be a vibrant, compact and mixed-use area with services and businesses that serve the community. Furthermore, existing vacant industrial lands in the Community Core have been identified to provide opportunities for development that respects the nearby Lake Athabasca. The Subject Property had also sat vacant until the applicant submitted their plans to develop it.
- 26. The Fort Chipewyan Area Structure Plan further supports the development of retail commercial, public service, and residential uses within the Community Core, as outlined in Policy 3.2.1. Additionally, Policy 3.3.1 allows a mix of commercial uses including retail uses in the Community Core.
- 27. The Land Use Bylaw 99/059 zones the Subject Property as HC Hamlet Commercial District (Section 110.3). Liquor Store, Office, and Warehouse Sales are all Discretionary Uses in this district.
- 28. In approving the Development Permit application, the Development Authority decided to impose a condition that restricts the hours of operation. This authority is granted under Section 27.2(a) of Land Use Bylaw 99/059.
- 29. Section 27.2, states:

[T]he Development Authority may, with respect to "Discretionary Uses – Development Officer" and "Discretionary Uses – Planning Commission", impose such conditions as the Development Authority deems appropriate, having regard for the regulations of this Bylaw and the provisions of any statutory plan in effect, including but not limited to the following:

(a) limiting hours or operation;

- (b) limiting number of patrons;
- (c) establishing landscaping requirements;
- (d) requiring noise attenuation;
- (e) requiring special parking provisions;
- (f) regarding the location, character and appearance of buildings;
- (g) regarding the grading of a site or other such procedures as are necessary to protect the site from other developments or to protect other developments from the site;
- (h) establishing the period of time during which a development may continue;
- (i) ensuring the development is compatible with surrounding development; and
- (j) ensuring the development complies with and is compatible with the development regulations or the land use district regulations of this Bylaw.
- 30. According to the Alberta Liquor, Gambling, and Cannabis Retail Liquor Store Handbook (2024), which outlines the AGLC's policies and requirements for Retail Liquor Store licensees, retail stores are permitted to operate from 9 a.m. to 2 a.m., Monday through Sunday. However, Condition #26 of Development Permit 2023-DP-00125 restricts the Liquor Store's hours of operation to 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Sunday.
- 31. The Development Authority imposed Condition #26 in response to concerns raised by individual residents and Mikisew Cree First Nation, who submitted letters regarding the Development Permit application. By restricting the Liquor Store's hours of operation, the Development Authority aimed to address the concern around accessibility and availability of alcoholic beverages within the community.

#### **Recommendation:**

32. The Development Authority recommends that the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board uphold the decision to restrict the Liquor Store's hours of operation as outlined in Condition #26, from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Sunday.

#### Rationale:

33. Based on the merits of the Development Permit application, the Development Authority found no grounds to refuse the application. However, considering the feedback from community members and the letter from Chief Tuccaro on behalf of the Mikisew Cree First Nation, it was important for the Development Authority to address the concerns raised. Within its authority, the Development Authority is empowered to impose conditions where appropriate, such as restricting the hours of operation for a proposed development. By restricting the Liquor Store's hours of operation, the Development Authority aimed to mitigate a primary community concern regarding the accessibility and availability of alcoholic beverages.

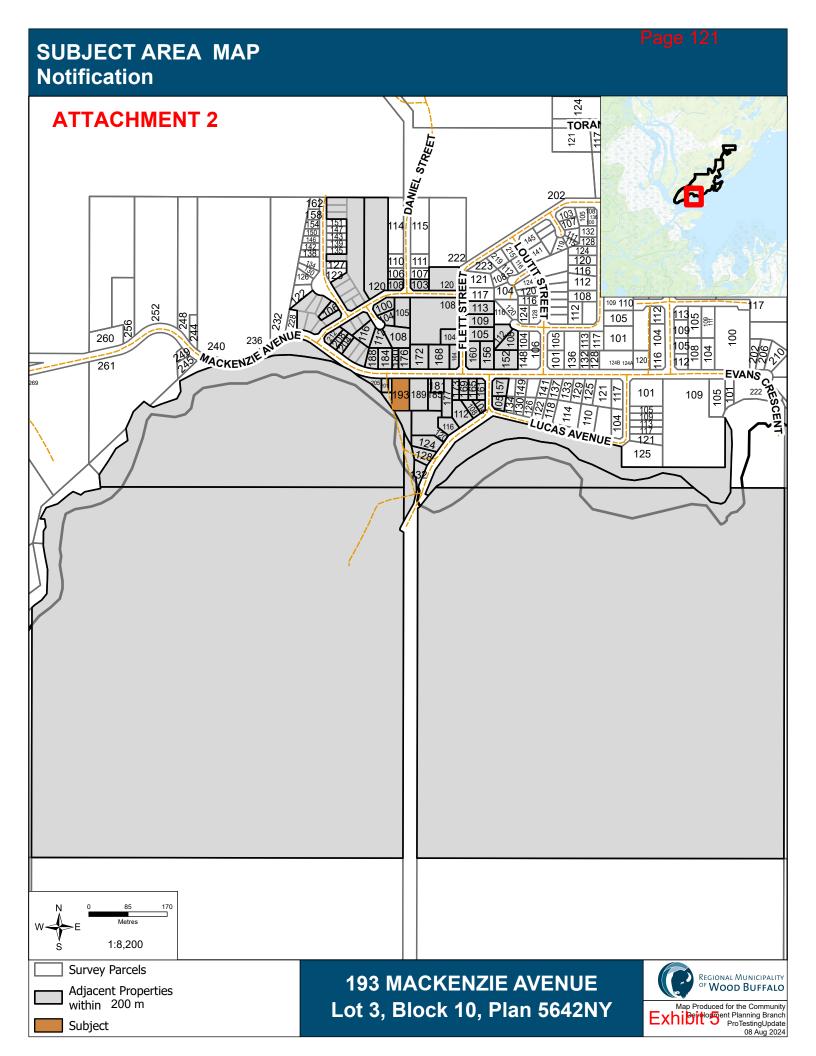
