



Fort Chipewyan Water Treatment Plant Update

(Fort Chipewyan, AB – July 14, 2026) – The RMWB is investigating several reports of discoloured tap water from residents that use the municipal water system in Fort Chipewyan.

Operators at the Fort Chipewyan water treatment plant have engaged external experts to provide support to make improvements in water clarity.

All recent test results indicate that tap water can continue to be used normally as the health parameters are being met in the Canadian Drinking Water Quality Guidelines. Additional water sampling and testing is being completed to better understanding what's causing the water discolouration. The additional water samples are being tested now at a third-party lab.

More updates will be provided to the community as additional testing results are received. The enhanced testing program at the Fort Chipewyan Water Treatment Plant continues to be in place with test results shared with the Nations and available at rmwb.ca/waterupdate
