Alberta; and

French-speaking people; and

**WHEREAS** the French-speaking population in the region has increased three-fold since

2001; and

**WHEREAS** the region has a strong, diverse, and vibrant French-speaking community,

which contributes to our social, economic and cultural fabric; and

WHEREAS the ACFA régionale de Wood Buffalo has been working in the region since 1980

by organizing events, providing community services and holding workshops;

and

WHEREAS 2018 marked the Government of Alberta's official proclamation of March as

Alberta Francophonie Month.

**NOW THEREFORE**, I, Sandy Bowman, Mayor of the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo, do hereby proclaim **March 2025** as:
