



Wood Buffalo (Provincial) Crime Statistic Summary – January to March

Wood Buffalo (Provincial) – Highlights

- **Break & Enters** are showing a 58.8% decrease when compared to the same period in 2025 (January to March). There were 10 fewer actual occurrences (from 17 in 2025 to 7 in 2026).
- **Theft of Motor Vehicles** decreased by 56.3% when compared to the same period in 2025 (January to March). There were 9 fewer actual occurrences (from 16 in 2025 to 7 in 2026).
- **Theft Under \$5,000** decreased by 33.3% when compared to the same period in 2025 (January to March). There were 11 fewer actual occurrences (from 33 in 2025 to 22 in 2026).

Wood Buffalo (Provincial) – Criminal Code Offences Summary

Crime Category	% Change 2025 – 2026 (January to March)
Total Persons Crime	29.8% Decrease
Total Property Crime	27.3% Decrease
Total Criminal Code	17.4% Decrease

From January to March 2026, when compared to the same period in 2025, there have been:

- 28 fewer **Persons Crime** offences;
- 48 fewer **Property Crime** offences; and
- 54 fewer **Total Criminal Code** offences;

Wood Buffalo (Provincial) – March, 2026

- There were 4 **Thefts of Motor Vehicles** in March: 0 cars, 0 trucks, 0 minivans, 2 SUVs, 0 motorcycles, 1 other types of vehicles, and 1 vehicles taken without consent.
- There were 2 **Break and Enters** in March: 0 businesses, 1 residences, 1 cottages/seasonal residences, 0 in some other type of location, and 0 unlawfully being in a dwelling house.
- There were a total of 1 **Provincial Roadside Suspensions** in March (0 alcohol related and 1 drug related). This brings the year-to-date total to 6 (5 alcohol related and 1 drug related).
- There were a total of 12 files with the **Spousal Abuse** survey code in March (March 2025: 18). This brings the year-to-date total to 26 (2025: 48).
- There were 333 files with **Victim Service Unit** referall scoring in Wood Buffalo Provincial: 3 accepted, 98 declined, 3 proactive, 0 requested but not available, and 229 files with no victim.



Wood Buffalo Provincial Crime Gauge

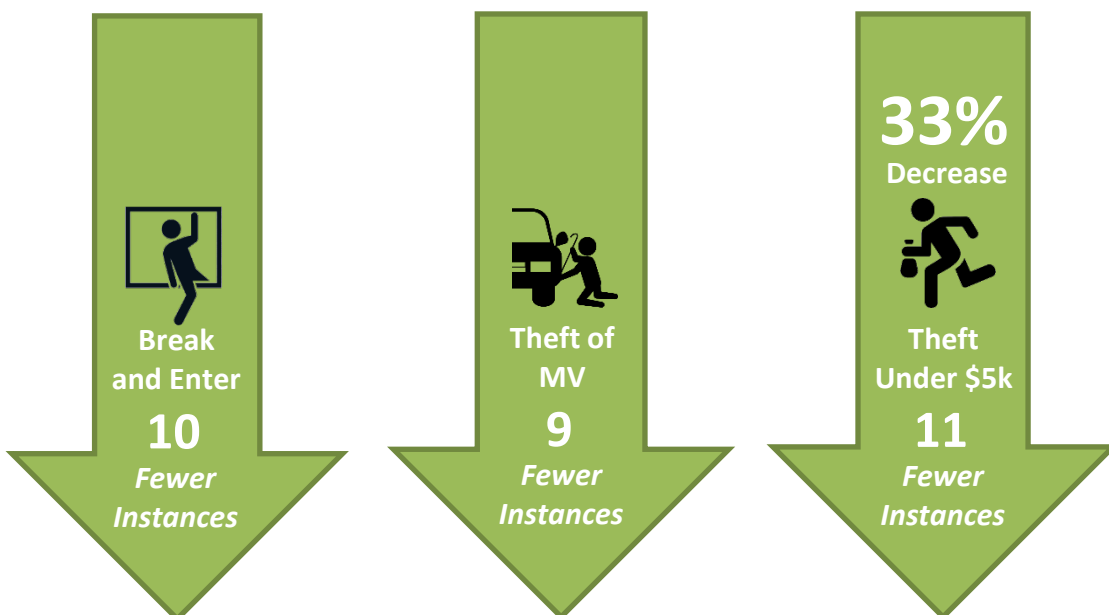
