Recommendation(s):

- 1. THAT Bylaw No. 25/015, being a text amendment to the Land Use Bylaw No. 99/059, and Land Use Bylaw No. 26/001, specific to mobile food vendors, be read a first time; and;
- 2. THAT the required Public Hearing be scheduled for June 24, 2025.

Summary | Background:

In order to bring forward a new Bylaw to formalize food trucks and street vending, being the "Food Truck and Street Vending Bylaw No. 25/014", an amendment to Land Use Bylaw No. 99/059 and to Land Use Bylaw No. 26/001 is required.

Alternatives:

Alternatively, the Municipality could choose not to amend both Land Use Bylaws and continue to permit mobile vending in Land Use Bylaw No. 99/059 and under Land Use Bylaw No. 26/001.

Budget | Financial Considerations:

Amending the Land Use Bylaws would have a negligible impact to the organization overall, with a minimal loss of \$150 per development permit application.
