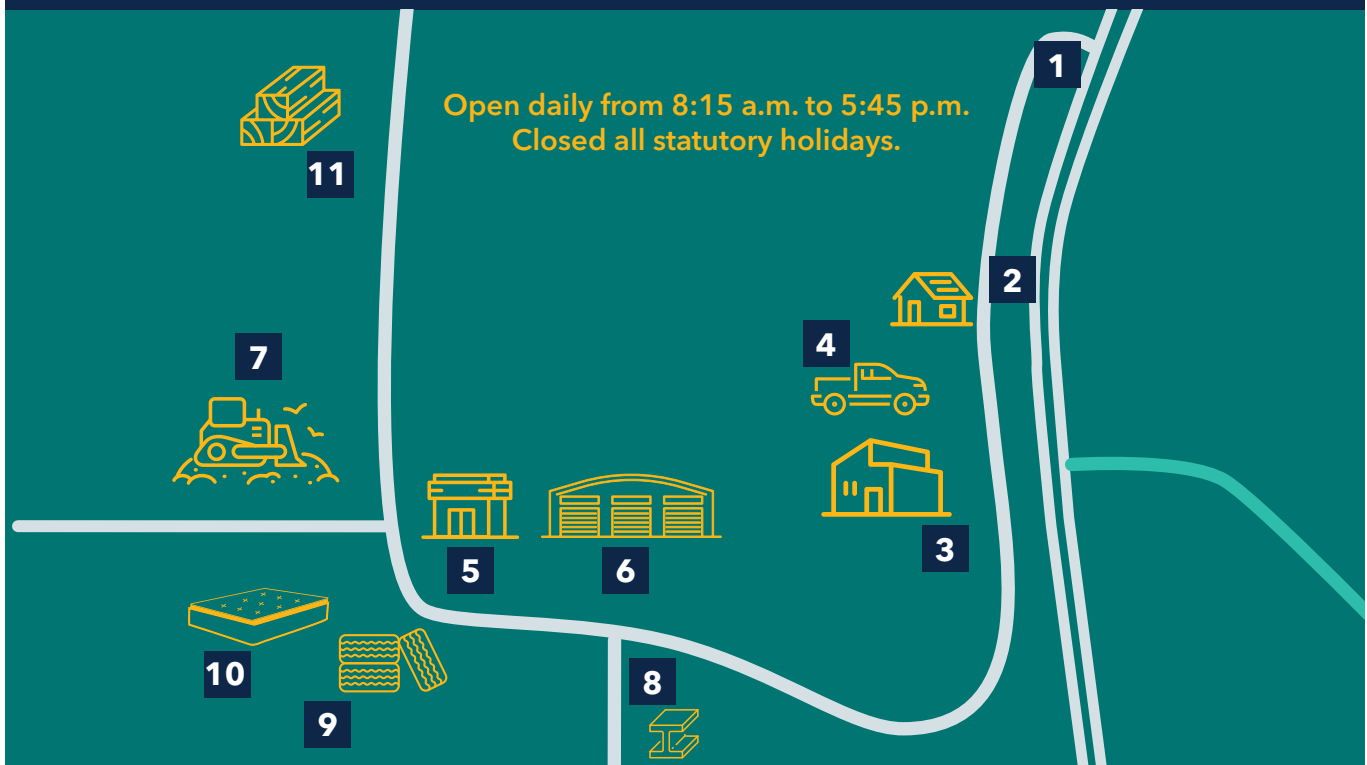




Welcome to the Municipal Landfill! This is a busy area with many vehicles coming and going. For your safety and the safety of everyone, please always:

- Drive cautiously. Follow all posted signage and instructions from staff.
- Keep children and pets in the vehicle.
- Keep at least 15 metres away from equipment. Municipal equipment has the right of way.
- Accurately inform the scale house of all the material you are disposing of.
- Properly dispose of material in the designated area
- No smoking or vaping on site.
- Remain respectful and patient. Verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- No salvaging or picking up of material at the landfill.

DUMPING INSTRUCTIONS AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

For commercial users or light vehicles with a dump trailer, you must follow these requirements while unloading material directly into the landfill.

- Wear personal protective equipment: steel-toe boots, high-visibility vest, safety glasses and gloves.
- Backup to the edge of the pad to dump your load. Do not dump loads in the middle or start of the pad.
- Remove the tarp on your load before backing up.
- Do not reverse for more than 50 metres.
- Use a spotter/flagger while backing up.
- Stay away from the bulldozer, especially when turning.
- Do not approach the dumping area when a bulldozer is backing up.
- Never walk up to the bulldozer unless eye contact is made first.
- Dump loads on the opposite side of where the bulldozer is working.
- Keep a safe distance from other vehicles and make wide turns when able.
- If you're not sure where to dump, stop in a safe location and staff will provide direction.



UNACCEPTABLE MATERIAL

While a wide range of material can be disposed of at the landfill, there are some items that aren't accepted.

- Free liquids
- Explosives
- Stone and rocks with a diameter greater than 1 foot (30 centimeters)
- Biomedical/biological/pathological waste
- Radioactive waste
- Oilfield waste
- Pesticides
- Bentonite and bentonite-contaminated products
- Asbestos
- Industrial abrasives
- Hazardous waste
- Material with mold
- Sulphur and sulphur-contaminated products
- Rig matts
- Creosote Poles or Railway ties
- Automobiles
- Conveyor belting or rubber excavator tracks
- Bulky waste material longer or wider than 4 feet (1.2 metres). E.g. hoses, pipes, cables, tanks, vessels, etc.
