WHEREAS those with disabilities can be more likely to face discrimination, including women with disabilities who experience gender-based violence at two-times of the rate of the general population; and

WHEREAS we encourage everyone to celebrate the accomplishments of people with disabilities, promote an understanding of barriers faced by people with disabilities, and mobilize support for the dignity, rights, access, and well-being of people with disabilities.
