Letter of Intent – To include a detailed description of the proposed project improvements, their intended benefits and which grant objectives the project meets. Please ensure descriptions and drawings are consistent. For applications requesting additional funding for accessibility and safety, the letter must describe the proposed improvements and how they will address accessibility and safety on a meaningful level. Ensure descriptions and drawings are consistent. Please complete Attachment 1. Façade Drawings<sup>3</sup> – Drawings for each façade being improved. Drawings must show the proposed design, including materials, colours, and product specifications. Product information may be attached. Sketch plans, renderings or construction drawings are acceptable for the Storefront and Simple Facade options. Comprehensive Façade Grants – Drawings must be professionally prepared (e.g. renderings or drafted construction plans). Site Plan<sup>3</sup> – A site plan is required for any work on land surrounding the building (e.g. ramps). The site plan must show the proposed location, layout, and dimension of improvements. **Preconstruction Photos** – Photos must show the current site and its context (JPEG or similar). П Certificate of Title<sup>4</sup> – Must be issued within the last **45 days**. For projects in condominiums, please also provide a Registered Change of Directors List, and a Condominium Plan Sheet.
