Fort McKay Water Treatment Plant – Update

January 13, 2025

Dear community member,

Essential maintenance work is continuing at the Fort McKay Water Treatment Plant. This work will require potable water to be temporarily supplied from Fort McMurray for approximately two weeks and is expected to begin on Friday, Jan. 17, 2025.

Water quality closely monitored and regularly tested

During this work, tap water will continue to be safe to drink with quality standards maintained and no interruptions to water service or pressure. The water quality in Fort McKay is closely monitored and regularly tested.

Construction update

The contractor is on-site and has begun work. Most construction activities are taking place inside, with no loud work anticipated. Equipment and construction activity will continue to follow the noise regulations in the Community Standards Bylaw.
